The World of Cesar Manrique

Experience **the world of Cesar Manrique**—celebrated artist, landscape conservationist, and one of Lanzarote's best-known citizens. Cross the northeastern part of the island to Jardin del Cactus, an unusual botanic garden where many species of cactus have been carefully arranged in a natural setting by Manrique himself. Then visit Manrique's former hom; now a museum. The house was des...
