## Tour Descriptions for Belize City, Belize

### BARRIER REEF & SNORKEL ISLAND BEACH BREAK

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_25

Board a high-speed catamaran and sail to a selected site where you'll enter an undersea world, home to a variety of corals. These coral formations are teeming with schools of colorful tropical fish. After snorkeling, enjoy some complimentary rum punch or soda on the short trip to an island where you'll be able to sunbathe or kayak. Play volley ball, have a snack at the restaurant, a drink at the full service bar or browse the gift shop.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women, guests with back or neck injuries, heart conditions, asthma or any other pre-existing or recurring medical conditions. We recommend you bring a towel and sunscreen.

### SHARKS, RAYS & ISLAND GETAWAY

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_65

Depart directly from the cruise pier on a comfortable motor vessel for a scenic approximately one hour minute boat ride to the charming tropical island of Caye Caulker. This historic little island is located along the edge of the Belize Barrier Reef, where the beautiful coral formations teeming with marine life, lay only a few hundred yards from the sandy beach. Your shark and ray encounter takes place on a shallow sand bar inside the reef. You'll enter the water in small groups with your expert guide who will entice the gentle, friendly marine animals to come close for your personal encounter. While floating or standing on the bottom, let your hands slide along the smooth sides of the sharks and rays as they swim by in close proximity. You'll be amazed how eager they are to visit you.

After your exciting encounter, board your waiting vessel for the short ride to the Barefoot Caribe Dock and Las Olas Restaurant, where you can purchase a local meal or snack, along with various beverages. This rustic venue has several thatched roof structures along the edge of the Caribbean, where you can sit and relax in a swinging chair or hang out in a hammock, enjoying the refreshing sea breeze. You can also explore the small island of Caye Caulker, home to a quaint fishing village and very friendly locals. Buy locally produced gift items from vendors along the unpaved "front street" or try something different – you can hand feed Tarpons. These large fish love to grab a sardine right out of your hand, as you stand or kneel on the dock. On your return to the pier on the boat your attentive crew will serve you complimentary rum punch (for those 21 years and older) or plain fruit punch while you listen to rhythmic Caribbean vibes. This fun and exciting day in paradise will long be remembered.

## CAVE TUBING & RAINFOREST TREK

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_03

Take a 90 minute guided bus ride to Jaguar Paw Outpost to some of the most sacred portals of the Mayan underworld. Upon arrival, you'll be given time to rent a locker and water shoes, fitted with your gear and receive a safety briefing. With tube in hand, take a 30 minute hike down a jungle trail while your your guide points out various plants once used by the ancient Mayans for medicinal purposes.

Floating on your inner tubes on the Cave Branch River, enjoy the open air and cool caverns with upclose view of the stalactites and exploring the many formations that adorn the caves. Your tour guide will narrate stories of the Mayan rituals and the history of the cave. Enjoy a Belizean lunch, as you reflect upon your expedition.

Note: Participants must be at least 10 years of age and at least 48 inches tall. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia in a very low percentage of guests. Guests with neck, back or mobility problems and pregnant women are not allowed to participate. Wear suitable footwear for muddy, wet trails. Wear your swimsuit and bring a change of clothes. Lockers are available for rent as personal belongings are not allowed to be left on the bus. Leave jewelry and valuables on the ship. Travel time is approximately 1 1/4 hours each way.

## CRYSTAL CAVE TUBING

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_09

Be prepared to be amazed by this adventure that puts you up close and personal with the unique phenomenon of crystal caves. Once you're provided with your life vest, helmet and head lamp, you'll begin your short hike, with tube in hand, to the secluded entrance of one of the intriguing caves. Your journey begins as you float into a chamber where high ceilings and a stalactite lined wall give the feeling of a cathedral.

As you paddle through the cavern, you are dwarfed by boulders rising up from the river, inviting you to explore further. Crystal encrusted cave formations dazzle you with their beauty as you meander up the river. But this is just a taste of what's to come. As you disembark your tube and enter the crystal chamber to explore the sacred underworld of the Maya, your guide will reveal hidden pottery dating back to 300-900 AD used by the Maya in ancient sacrificial ceremonies.

A "frozen water fall" column and glittering stone dam are just a few of the amazing formations you'll encounter in this Gothic chamber. Back in your tube, you'll make your way to an underground lagoon bordered by a mini waterfall, which signals the end of your subterranean adventure. Don't forget to visit the photo desk to buy a

memento from the photographers who captured spectacular shots of you on your adventure. Enjoy a delicious Belizean lunch of stewed chicken, rice & beans and coleslaw, as you reflect upon your expedition.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and at least 48 inches high. Bring swimsuit or shorts and a t-shirt, a change of clothes, towel and insect repellent. Lockers and water shoes are available for rent. Leave jewelry and valuables on the ship.

Upon arrival at your hidden destination, your skilled high angle guides will fit you with your harness and give you a safety briefing before you get started. Feel the rush as you fly 500 ft across the jungle for a bird’s eye view of a cavernous opening to one of the Mayas ancient ceremonial caves and the starting point of your next adventure. Adrenaline pumping and anticipation high, it’s time to switch gears from harness to life vests as the second leg of you quest begins.

Be prepared to be wowed by this adventure that puts you up close and personal with the unique phenomenon of crystal caves. Explore the unique stalactites and dazzling formations including a “frozen water fall” column and glittering rim stone dam. Back in your tube, you’ll make your way to an underground lagoon bordered by a mini waterfall which signals the end of your subterranean adventure. Enjoy a delicious Belizean lunch as you reflect on the expedition you’ve just experienced.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, at least 48 inches high and weigh no more than 265 lbs. Guests must be in good physical condition and able to walk 35 minutes on uneven jungle trail. Guests with neck, back, mobility problems and pregnant women are not allowed to participate. Bring swimsuit or shorts and t-shirt, a change of clothes, towel and insect repellent. Shorts must be worn on the zipline portion of this tour. Water shoes and lockers are available for rent at the site. Leave jewelry and valuables on the ship.

## ZIPLINE ADVENTURE & CAVE TUBING

**Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_29**

Adventure at its Best! Zip through the lush Belizean jungle and then tube through the ancient caves of the Maya in the Cave Branch River. Take a guided ride to Jaguar Paw Outpost where on arrival your skilled guides will assist you with renting lockers and water shoes and then you’ll be fitted with your gear and given a safety briefing.

You're now ready for your zipline adventure through a lush tropical rainforest on 5 thrilling traverses and after, you'll tube through the ancient Maya caves. Certified cave tubing guides will recount the history and rituals of the Maya who settled in these caves. Enjoy a Belizean lunch as you reflect upon your experience.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh at least 95 lbs. and no more than 250 lbs. The cave system and its waterways may cause claustrophobia in a very small percentage of guests. Guests with neck or back, mobility problems and pregnant women are not allowed to participate. Wear a swimsuit, tennis shoes (which will get wet) or water shoes and bring a towel. Shorts must be worn on the zipline portion of this tour. Leave jewelry and valuables on the ship. Travel time is approximately 1 1/4 hours each way.

## HELLS GATE ROCK RAFTING OR RIVER TUBING

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_46

Hells Gate Rock Rafting or River Tubing Tour is designed for guests that wish to relax and enjoy the beautiful scenic jungle, floating down the Sibun River in Belize. Choose between rafting or tubing. The entrance to the tour is only a few minutes hike. Gentle steps down from the rock formations will allow for an easy and safe entrance to the river either in your tube, if you want to cool off or a raft, if you want to stay dry.

Your guide will point out the jungle fauna and the iguanas that reside along the river banks, as you enter Hells Gate Rock area. You'll stop at a large rock outcropping that has a small shallow bay - take a swim or enjoy a snack and a water break before heading back to the river. You'll enter deeper rapids and feel the rush as you meet the Caves Branch River. You may swim, if desired before ascending the stairway to the Hell Gate Bar and Restaurant. Here you can relax, eat and drink at your own expense, while enjoying the sounds of the river.

## LAMANAI RUINS & RIVER SAFARI

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_08

An approximate 45 minute drive up the Northern Highway brings you to Tower Hill, where you'll board a riverboat and head up the New River. While navigating the many little creeks and lagoons, you may encounter hawks, kites and falcons. Dainty jacanas lightly walk on the lily pads while crocodiles bask in the sunlight. At the entrance to the New River Lagoon, the ruins of Lamanai, Mayan for "submerged crocodile" rise into view.

As you tour the site, huge masks depicting dead rulers and gods seem to materialize out of the rainforest, amid the chatter of birds and the haunting call of the howler monkeys. After your tour of Lamanai it is time to head downriver to Tower Hill for a lunch buffet of Belizean and Mayan favorites. Following lunch, you'll board a

coach bound for the Belize City docks, where you'll board your tender to go back to the ship.

## ALTUN HA MAYAN RUINS

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_02

This fascinating half-day tour focuses on the contrast between the ancient Mayan city of Altun Ha and modern day Belize City, highlighting 1,000 years of development. Altun Ha is Mayan for "Rock Stone Water" thrived as a trading post to the Mayan world during the Classic and Post Classic periods. The site was made world famous by Dr. David Pendergast of the Royal Ontario Museum upon his discovery of the world's largest carved Jade Head, depicting the sun god Kinich Ahau. Weighing in at almost 9 pounds, this has been Belize's most valuable find.

Belize City today is home to about 35% of the country's population and remains the commercial capital of the country. Your tour will pass by historical sites such as redbrick St. John's Cathedral, where Kings from the Mosquito Coast were crowned. The tour ends at the Smoky Mermaid for complimentary drinks.

Note: The Belize City tour portion is conducted on a bus without stops.

## ALTUN HA & THE OLDE BELIZE RIVER

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_06

Enjoy a quaint river cruise on a semi-covered river boat on the historic Belize River. Keep your eyes out for manatees, crocodiles, howler monkeys, iguanas and a wide variety of birds in their natural habitat. At the end of the river tour savor a delicious Belizean lunch at Olde River Tavern Restaurant.

Later, board an air conditioned tour bus continuing on to the ancient Mayan city of Altun Ha where the famous Jade Head of Kinich Ahau was discovered. This once striving city and trade center comprises 13 structures, including the Temple of the Masonry Altar or Sun God Temple that surrounds two plazas. Your tour guide will share a brief history and culture of Belize during the bus transfer.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. Guests in wheelchairs, those with physical limitations, and pregnant women are not permitted to participate. Boats are semi-covered with some areas exposed to the elements, please plan accordingly. Wear comfortable sturdy close-toed shoes. We recommend that you wear a hat and bring insect repellent. If needed ponchos are available for purchase on tour boat. This tour is operated where group will be split into two groups, half do river portion first and other half will do drive through the city en route to Altun Ha Site.

## MAYAN RUINS - ALTUN HA AND BACAB JUNGLE PARK

Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_45

Your adventure to Altun Ha and Bacab Jungle Park begins in the comfort of an air-conditioned motorcoach on your way to the ruins, where you'll learn about the Old Capital, Belize City and the ancient Maya. The approximate 60 minute drive will take you through scenic views of the savanna, Broadleaf Forest and picturesque villages before arriving, this ancient Maya city. Altun Ha takes you back to a Land of Gods where the largest piece of carved jade known from the ancient Maya civilization depicting the Sun God, Kinich Ahau was discovered in a tomb of a high priest atop the Temple of the Masonry Altars. A climb to the top of one of the temples offers a view of the site and surrounding tropical forest.

After exploring Altun Ha, a 25 minute ride brings you to Bacab Eco Park. Enjoy the pool with its waterslide and sculpted waterfall - ideal for swimming, lounging or simply cooling down, especially after climbing the ruins. A Belizean buffet style lunch is available at your leisure. Take advantage of the park's other amenities including Ixchel's Walk, a self-guided medicinal, botanical trail. When available, for a small fee, visit the Wild Wings Butterfly House and learn about the colorful native butterflies. Afterwards, kick off your shoes and relax in one of many hammocks in the shade of a Buttonwood tree and sip a frozen drink made with local fruit. Visit the gift shops for a variety of Belizean made arts and crafts, and other souvenirs.

Note: This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or anyone with a heart condition. Must be able to walk at a slow pace for 45 minutes. Long sleeve shirts, long pants and closed-toe shoes are recommended. Bring a swimsuit, sunglasses, hat, towel, sunscreen and insect repellent.

The freeform pool with its waterslide and sculpted waterfall is ideal for swimming, lounging or simply cooling down. style. If relaxing is not for you, then learn about the many uses of native plants on Ixchel’s Walk, a self-guided medicinal, botanical trail. You can also stroll along a winding pathway in the Wild Wings Butterfly House if available, at a small additional charge. Here you can learn about the intricate lives of native Central American butterflies.

The free form pool with its water slide and sculpted waterfall is ideal for swimming, lounging or simply cooling down. At your leisure, enjoy a delicious typical Belizean lunch prepared just for you served buffet style. If relaxing is not for you, then learn about the many uses of native plants on Ixchel’s Walk, a self-guided medicinal, botanical trail. Or when available, stroll along a winding pathway in the Wild Wings Butterfly House at a small additional charge. Here you’ll learn about the intricate lives of native Central American butterflies.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and weigh no more than 260 lbs. Horse riding time is approximately one hour. Pregnant women are prohibited from horseback riding. ## BARRIER REEF – TWO TANK SCUBA DIVE

**Belize City, Belize Tour Code: BZE\_99**

The Barrier Reef dives are based on diving the many varied sites, along the central part of the Belize Barrier Reef, from Gallows Point Reef to Sergeant's Caye. Deep walls spur and groove formations, colorful corals and sponges, along with an abundance of marine life both large and small will ensure that your dive is varied. You'll be picked up directly at the cruise ship and take a 30 minute boat ride to the dive center at a private island on the way to the Barrier Reef.

Dive Masters will provide a safety briefing and dive orientation after your equipment has been issued and set-up. All dive sites are within 15 to 20 minutes from the dive center. A 45 to 50 minute dive at two sites with snacks, fruit slices, purified drinking water and non-alcoholic beverage are available during surface interval. Groups are broken down into teams of 8 maximum per dive master, who will plan and lead the dive pointing out interesting features and marine life during the tour. Enjoy a short stop at the private island at the end of the tour before returning to your ship. A restaurant, bar, private beach and gift shop are available on location.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and be physically fit for SCUBA diving. Completion of a waiver is required. Due to restrictions by the Dive Provider, any SCUBA participants currently taking any

medication or with a previous medical condition should bring a note from their primary physician stating that they are medically cleared to participate on a SCUBA excursion. Dive Certification Card and proof of diving at least once within the past 12 months is required. Equipment including a wet suit is available for an additional charge, only tanks and weights are provided.
