
## **Ackers Point Guided Walk**

With more than 115 miles of coastline and many small islands, **Paterson Inlet** is one of the most beautiful natural harbors in New Zealand. From the Golden Bay wharf, you'll board a chartered 75-foot **high-speed catamaran** and commence your cruise towards Paterson Inlet. # **Pelagic Bird Cruise**
