Centrale Manic Dam

Combine a visit to **Manic-2**, a spectacular **hollow-joint gravity dam**, with an introduction to Baie-Comeau. Manic-2 is an important hollow-joint gravity dam. Amazingly, it is the size of a Boeing 747 and was the first one to be put into service at the Manic-Outardes complex. It is here that, in 1965, Hydro-Québec operated the first 735,000-volt line in the world. This type of li...
