Dive Rangiroa: One-Tank Certified Dive

Scuba diving is available, fun and consistent all year round. The water is warm (79°F to 84°F) and thanks to a usual amazing visibility (from 70 feet to 150 feet), a great number of large species can be observed around most of the islands-turtles, sting rays, eagle rays, jackfish, barracudas, sharks, eels, Napoleon wrasses, dolphins, tunas, schools ...

Glass-Bottom Boat

Here is a wonderfully easy way to get acquainted with the coral gardens and tropical fish of Rangiroa. Enjoy this visual excursion with an up-close look at French Polynesia's busy underwater scene. Board a **glass-bottom boat** and float slowly over the huge coral heads that cluster in shallow areas inside the **Tiputa Channel**. Look through large windows that open onto a colorful world ...

Snorkel the Aquarium Garden

A local **boat** will depart the pier for a **transfer** over to the **natural, open-water aquarium** for an exciting **snorkeling experience**. At one of the best snorkel spots on the atoll, admire the wonderful and colorful underwater world of tropical fish and coral formation.

Visit the Pearl Farm

Transfer by bus along the main road of Rangiroa, passing the airport just before turning into the **Black Pearl Farm**. Most pearl farms are small in size, and the number of staff here is quite typical of the farms in this region.
