Aros Park Coastal Walk

Depart from the harbor in Tobermory **on foot** with your knowledgeable guide. The path leads away from the marina and climbs gently through the woodland along the side of Tobermory Bay. You'll have fabulous views out to Calve Island, possibly even glimpsing some seals out on the skerries. Follow the track to the old pier, where timber was once shipped from the Aros Estate for building...

Duart Castle

The excursion commences from the colorful little town of Tobermory. Heading south toward **Duart Castle**, skirt the east coast of the isle for breathtaking views across the Sound of Mull to the Morvern Peninsula. Mull is famous for its rugged beauty and unspoiled landscapes, which you will become acquainted with on your journey. Duart Castle, perched on a rocky promontory known as Dubh Ard ...

The Isles of Mull & Iona

Beginning your tour from colorful, postcard-perfect Tobermory, you'll board a motor coach for the wonderfully scenic drive to Salen. Branching off on the west coast route, follow the banks of Loch Scridain to Fionnphort at the western tip of Mull. Here, you'll board the **ferry** on foot for the 10-minute journey across to the tiny island of **Iona**. White sandy beaches and t...

Western Mull Panoramic

Head west from Tobermory, traveling along a charming, winding road. You're headed to the Viking-Age village of Dervaig, nestled beside narrow Loch Chumhainn. Distinguished by its unusual snow-white conical church spire and a single street of tiny, whitewashed cottages and old corrugated-iron shacks, Dervaig is a photograph waiting to happen. Continue along the beautiful scenic coastal rou...
