Polar Experience & Wilderness Center

Scenic Rib Adventure

A **cruise** by RIB (**rigid inflatable boat**) is a great way to enjoy the scenery in the sheltered waters near Tromsø. View the sights, look for wildlife and listen to stories as you proceed towards Ryøya Island. With a little bit of luck you might spot eagles in the sky and/or harbor porpoises in the water. At Ryøya Island there is a small herd of musk oxen...
