Set among a tropical fruit orchard, with a babbling river flowing through the middle, the Mari Mari Cultural Village will take you on a journey back in time to the days of the legendary headhunters and other indigenous people of Borneo. Upon arrival at the entrance to the village, visit homes showcasing the diverse ethnicities of Sabah. Each home was built by descendants of the tribes it represents, and offers a truly genuine cultural experience. Acquaint yourself with each tribe and learn about their modern-day lives. As you walk through the village, you will find demonstration huts where the daily activities of yesteryear come to life**Sabah delicacies**, where you can taste herbal drinks and rice wine, and learn how to cook chicken in bamboo **traditional dances** with the famous Murut Megunatip, or bamboo dance, as the finale.

The jagged granite peaks of Mt Kinabalu (13,400 feet) towers above one of the most biologically diverse areas in the world. A **UNESCO World Heritage Site, Kinabalu Park** is a natural wonder that offers day visitors a glimpse into the fascinating world of plant life within the park. Enjoy a walk through oak and chestnut rain forests at the **park headquarters**. You'll view some of the 1,200 species of orchids, nine species of carnivorous pitcher plants and 25 species of rhododendrons found here. On a clear day, the mountain is quite spectacular as you can see the jagged peaks towering above. You will cross the Crocker Range, passing through rustic countryside and seeing the native Dusun people. Notes:

The temperature in the mountains is relatively cool; bring a jacket.

Spread over 300 acres of valley and hilly terrain, the park aims to educate the public on wildlife and environmental conservation, research into captive management, rescue native animals for treatment or rehabilitation and reproduction of endangered species. Complete your Borneo experience with a stop at the **Heritage Village**to learn more about the ethnic groups found in Borneo. Gain a closer view of Sabah's cultural diversity highlighted by the distinctive local architectural style and the unusual materials they use, such as bamboo, tree bark and Nipah leaves. Learn about the traditions of **headhunting** at the Skull Hut as well as the lifestyles of the different groups.
