Head to the **Triple Beach View Point** for a spectacular panoramic view of Karon, Kata and Kata Noi Beaches on the west coast of Phuket. Then, you will continue up Nakkerd Hill to see the **Big Buddha** made of reinforced concrete and Burmese marble. Almost 150 feet tall, it is a landmark and symbol of Phuket. The peak offers a stunning vista of the island. Your next stop will be at the **Kratu Tin Mine Museum**, where you can learn about Phuket's hidden history with a mock-up of old-time tin mines. Also pertinent is some interesting information about the very first Chinese immigrants, who have now become Phuket's main residents and have developed the unique heritage of today's Phuket. Enjoy a delicious **lunch**before returning to the port.

Panoramic Phuket





Here's an ideal opportunity to see some of the finest sights Phuket has to offer from the comfort of an air-conditioned motor coach. A local guide keeps you fully informed as you pass a kaleidoscope of villages, temples, mosques, markets and beaches. Your **panoramic drive** takes in the city's graceful atmosphere, and you will glimpse exterior views of old Sino-Portuguese-style buildings, the local market, and the Chinese shrine. Next, head north passing the Two Heroine Monument, built to commemorate two Thai women who saved Phuket from a Burmese invasion in the 18th century. A short stop here allows you to have a closer look at the two ladies. Watch for the island's biggest mosque at Bang Tao Village—living proof of three major communities living together in harmony. The next sector involves a drive along the coastal road passing Surin, Kamala, Patong and Karon beaches. You will also see Chalong Temple—Phuket's most sacred place of worship—with an unusual layout for a Buddhist temple.



The unparalleled scenery of **Phang Nga Bay** offers dramatic amber-hued limestone outcroppings contrasting vividly with the startling blue of the ocean. Your sightseeing will begin with a journey north, where you will cross to the mainland over the Sarasin Bridge. Soon you'll reach spectacular Phang Nga Bay and board a **boat** to cruise through this picture-perfect waterway. Your boat also passes Khao Ping Gun (James Bond Island), where the movie *The Man with the Golden Gun*, was filmed in 1974. Tidal conditions permitting, you'll stop at **Koh Panyi water village**, where 400 houses are built on stilts and are connected by wooden walkways. A buffet **lunch** will be served at the Phang Nga Bay Resort, which overlooks the nearby mangrove forest and towering hills.

Visit fabulous **Phi Phi Island**, regarded by travelers from all walks of life as being among the most beautiful tropical settings in the world. The famous movie, *The Beach*, starring Leonardo DiCaprio was filmed here on Phi Phi. The island and nearby Noppharat Thara Beach are now a **National Park**. Phi Phi Island and the coastal hills are composed mainly of limestone and are an extension of the limestone mountain range in Phang Nga Province, with steep cliffs, large caves and dwarf trees growing out of the rock crevices, and are well known for fine beaches and coral formations. Among emerald-colored, crystal-clear seas, secluded beaches, mountain cliffs, colorful coral reefs and undersea life, you will enjoy fantastic **snorkeling** and **beach** time at this tropical paradise in the Andaman Sea. A buffet lunch includes one soft drink or local beer.

Sea Canoe Adventure




