Mataram Highlights





Your Mataram city tour starts with a visit to the large Lingsar temple complex built in 1714. This is the most important temple on the island for the Balinese and for the local Sasak people who adhere to Wetu Telu Islam. Not to be outdone, the Hindu temple lies in the northern section and is higher than the Wetu Telu temple. Its fountain contains fish that are believed to appear only when a person's wish is going to be granted. Do you see them? Lombok is renowned for its pearls, so you will visit the pearl shops in the center of Mataram. You'll also stop at the Sayang Art Market. Lombok's potters are excellent craftsmen, and Lombok is also famous for its baskets, finely woven from strips of rattan, banana leaves and other vegetable fibers, and as well as wood carvings. Finally, you'll visit the Nusa Tenggara Barat Museum to see its cloth collection, the Kris knives and a small Dongson drum. Most of the displays have captions in English. Don't miss the display of "mystical" paraphernalia—amulets used to acquire supernatural force, immunity from weapons or to foretell the future. Your immediate future holds a motor coach ride back to the pier.

Sasak Native Village & Kuta Beach





Central Lombok is home to **Sade-Rambitan**, a traditional **Sasak village**. En route to the village, you'll pass beautiful scenery of rice fields and palm trees, and stop at Banyu Mulek—famous for handmade pottery. Enjoy a *cidomo* ride (**traditional horse cart**) to see the skilled villagers processing clay into beautiful export-quality pottery. At the local school, children are trained to make pottery from a very young age. A visit to a large gallery is included, where you can purchase the finished products. Sukarara, your next stop, is a village known for *Ikat* and handwoven fabric. Arriving at Sade-Rambitan, you'll discover a village of **traditional Sasak houses**. They enclose an interior platform raised about a yard off the ground, and made of the mixture of clay, dung and straw, that has been polished to a high gloss. The roof is thatch, and the walls are bamboo or palm leaf ribs. Sade also features many of the piled, bonnet-shaped rice barns (*lumbungs*) which are the symbol of Lombok. Kuta Beach offers the best seascape in Lombok and an Indonesian buffet **lunch** is served here at a beautiful tropical resort. **Free time** is available at the resort, so relax and enjoy hotel's **swimming pool** or the crystal-clear blue water of the **beach** before returning to the port.

The Fascinating Culture of Lombok





Explore the fascinating culture of Lombok with a visit to Nusa Tenggara Barat Province Museum. Its highlights are the cloth collection, the fine Kris knives and a small Dongson drum. Most of the displays have captions in English. One showcase holds "mystical" paraphernalia with amulets used to acquire supernatural force, immunity from weapons or to foretell the future. Your tour then proceeds to Narmada Water Palace. The centerpiece here is a large artificial lake whose shape resembles Segara Anak in the caldera of the Rinjani Volcano. It was built in 1805 by the Raja of Mataram after he became too old to climb Rinjani to deposit offerings in the sacred lake there, and the replica of the volcano's lake was a substitute a repository for the Raja's offerings. Narmada's temple, Pura Kalasa, is still used and the Balinese Pujawali celebration is held here annually. Lingsar, another large temple complex built in 1714, is the place of worship for Wetu Telu Islam. The Hindu temple is in the northern section and features a fountain. Continue heading north and the road rises over two small hills offering panoramic views of the sea. Enjoy a sumptuous Indonesian buffet lunch served at an international restaurant at the Senggigi Resort. In the central city of Mataram, you'll stop to visit the famous pearl shops. More shopping opportunities abound at Banyu Mulek village, famous for handmade pottery. Take a cidomo ride (traditional horse cart) around the village to see the skilled villagers processing clay into beautiful export-quality pottery. At the local school, children are trained to make pottery from a very young age. A visit to a large gallery is included, where you can purchase the finished products.
