## Tour Descriptions for Berlin (Rostock), Germany

### BEST OF BERLIN

**Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_43**

Board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival at one of Berlin's train stations, your local tour guide will welcome and assist you to board your coach. Depart on an exciting tour of Berlin, covering the top ten highlights of this bustling city. Photo stops will be made at the East Side Gallery, a 3/4 mile long section of the Berlin wall, Checkpoint Charlie and at the Bebelplatz where below the ground level lays the Empty Library. You'll pass by the Potsdamer Platz, formerly a no man's land between East and West where the first gap in the Berlin Wall was made in 1989, and which is today a pristine block of futuristic glass and steel skyscrapers.

A few blocks away from here, at the Holocaust Memorial, you'll have another opportunity for a photo stop before making your way over to the famous Brandenburg Gate and the Reichstag government building. Before continuing your sightseeing tour, you'll enjoy a traditional German pub-style lunch at a local restaurant. Next, enjoy an outside visit to the Charlottenburg Palace, the oldest surviving Prussian palace, and then drive into the former western part of Berlin, along the Kurfuerstendamm, where you'll pass by the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial church and the largest department store on the continent of Europe, the KaDeWe. Continue passing Berlin's main train station with more than 80 shops that are all open seven days a week. Also, see the Victory column commemorating the Prussian victories. Depending on the order of the tour and timing, you'll have the opportunity to either spend some time at leisure at the Kurfuerstendamm, Friedrichstrasse, Unter den Linden Boulevard or Berlin's Main Train Station (or similar), before transferring to the station for your return journey.

### PANORAMIC BERLIN & CONCENTRATION CAMP

**Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_41**

Board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival at one of Berlin's train stations, your local tour guide will welcome and assist you to board your coach. Your panoramic tour of Berlin will include passing by Bebel Platz, where below the ground level lies the Empty Library; remnants of the Berlin Wall; the famous former border crossing, Check-Point-Charlie; the Brandenburg Gate, which more than any other

monument symbolizes the German and European reunification; the Reichstag government building; Berlin's Protestant cathedral with its Neo-Baroque interior and massive dome; Haeckesche Hoefe, a building complex built by Jewish idealists in 1906-07 with elegant ceramic facades, and which today symbolizes Berlin's new center having miraculously survived two wars; and the New Synagogue, Berlin's most prominent Jewish landmark.

Stop at the Holocaust Memorial, the 'Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe', which is a central place for remembrance to the murdered victims and a place of warning. After lunch at a traditional German pub-style restaurant, start the second part of your tour heading for the infinitely more somber and one of the most chilling destinations, the former Nazi Concentration Camp at Sachsenhausen, a memorial just north of Berlin. About 6,000 Jews were forcibly brought here after Kristallnacht alone, and it was here that some of the first experiments in organized mass murder were made. The scale of the terror remembered here can be very disturbing, however, simply by visiting here you can help change the future; as Winston Churchill put it, "the further backward you can look, the further forward you are likely to see."

## PANORAMIC BERLIN & HISTORIC POTSDAM

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_40

Board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival at one of Berlin's suburban train stations, your local tour guide will welcome and assist you to board your coach. During your panoramic tour of colorful Berlin, you'll stop at a remnant of the Berlin Wall and the famous former border crossing, Check-Point-Charlie. From here you'll continue to the Brandenburg Gate, which more than any other monument symbolizes the German and European reunification. Close by you'll pass the Reichstag government building and the newly erected Holocaust Memorial. Drive along the Kurfurstendamm, Berlin's version of the Champs Elysees and pass the Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church before you circle the Gendamenmarkt, home to the German Dom and French Dom.

Before starting the second part of your exciting tour, you'll stop for lunch at one of the local restaurants. After lunch, continue your tour to Potsdam. Upon arrival at Potsdam, enjoy a panoramic tour of this capital of the Brandenburg State, with its Baroque city center and numerous palaces. Your next visit will be to the magnificent centerpiece of Potsdam and summer residence of Frederick the Great, the Palace of Sanssouci, set above six vineyard terraces and one of the most beautiful remaining examples of French-Prussian Rococo architecture. Depart this UNESCO World Heritage Site across the Glienicke Bridge. Here is where spies were swapped between the American and the Soviet sectors during the Cold War. From there you proceed back to the train station in Berlin for your return journey to Berlin.

## BERLIN HIGHLIGHTS & LEISURE TIME

Board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival at one of Berlin's train stations, your local tour guide will welcome and assist you to board your coach. Your sightseeing tour begins with an overview of some of the major highlights of Berlin. You'll pass by remnants of the Berlin Wall, Alexanderplatz Square, Checkpoint Charlie, the Red City Hall, Unter den Linden Boulevard, Gendarmenmarkt Square, Potsdam Square, the Victory Column, Bellevue Palace, Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag government building and Bebelplatz with the Empty Library memorial.

After passing these world-famous landmarks and attractions, you'll have the opportunity to spend approximately 3 hours on your own to visit a museum, do some shopping or return to some of the sights for closer inspection. After your time at leisure, you'll meet your escort at a central point and return by coach to the train station, where you board your private train for the return journey.

Are you the type of person who wants to explore a destination on your own? Then don't miss this convenient opportunity for an organized transfer into the heart of Berlin. Board your exclusively chartered standard train for an approximate 2 1/2 to 3 hour journey to Berlin. While relaxing and watching the German countryside pass by, you'll be served a light snack. Upon arrival at one of Berlin's train stations, your escort will accompany you on a short coach transfer to a central drop off point in Berlin from where you'll explore Berlin on your own. Return to a central train station in the early evening as your escort has instructed you, for your return train journey.

Note: Upon arrival at Berlin station, you'll receive a short coach transfer from the station to a central drop point. You spend time on your own in Berlin and also return to the departure station on your own. The tour price does not include any entrance fees, lunch or guiding services. This may cause a variation in time for exploration. ## BEST OF ROSTOCK

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_38

This tour covers the top ten sights of the Hanseatic city of Rostock and is the best way to ensure you do not miss the highlights. Begin with an approximate 30 minute ride into the heart of the city, followed by a panoramic tour of the city by coach before you disembark and cover most of the sights on foot. Step back in time on a city walk through Rostock, Mecklenburg Vorpommern's largest city.

You'll pass by the University of Rostock, the oldest and largest university in continental northern Europe, a city gate which survived the ravages of time, the 'New Market' Square lined with six original carefully preserved, gable houses from the 15th and 16th centuries, the Town Hall and St. Mary's Church, an imposing brick Gothic church built in the 13th century. See the convent of the Holy Cross, the adjacent medieval city wall, modern functional buildings built in the 1960s and in contrast the little fishing village Warnemunde, acquired by Rostock's town council in 1323. This tour is a compilation of the best sightseeing attractions Rostock has to offer!

Note: The order of the sights may vary. Inside visit of St. Mary's Church is not part of the tour. You may visit the church on your own leisure time. This tour will only be offered on offered on Norwegian Star August 27th, 2016 sailing.

## ENCHANTING WISMAR & BREWERY

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_33

Depart by coach for an approximate 75-minute journey to Wismar, a medieval beauty founded in 1229. Upon arrival you'll enjoy a guided walk and explore this quaint Hanseatic city which is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Walk along cobbled streets with Gothic houses, Baroque buildings and Renaissance facades. The

classic Town Hall, the water tower, the historic drainage system and merchants' houses from the Middle Ages are just some of the fascinating buildings this town has to offer.

Stop for refreshments at a nostalgic brewery/pub started in the Middle Ages to taste some medieval 'Mumme' beer, which the citizens of Wismar drank during the Hanseatic period. Along with your beer tasting, you'll be served some traditional German snacks.

## SCHWERIN AND ITS FAIRYTALE CASTLE

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_34

Depart Rostock by coach and transfer directly to "fairytale" Schwerin. Upon arrival, you'll be taken on a guided walk of the old town. Your walk will cover the main highlights, such as the historical buildings in the old town, the Mecklenburg State Theatre and the medieval Schwerin Cathedral, an imposing Romanesque Gothic red-brick building. Spend some time on your own for lunch, maybe a boat ride depending on boat schedule or some shopping before you get to see the magnificent "Schloss Schwerin".

It is a picturesque palace located on an island, considered the capital's most famous building. Take a guided walk through Schloss Schwerin, also called "Neuschwanstein" of the North, to admire the beautiful interior. The gardens with their majestic beauty, offer a stunning view of the castle, which was built on the foundation of a Slavic castle and documenting the growth of power and wealth.

## ROSTOCK BY TRAM & RIVER CRUISE

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_32

After a short transfer to the main tramway station, board an exclusive tram, which is still Rostock's main transportation system, and ride into the heart of the city. Upon arrival, step back in time to see the highlights of Rostock, Mecklenburg Vorpommern's largest city, during a guided walk. Proceed to northern Europe's oldest university, the University of Rostock, founded in 1419 and built in Italian Renaissance style. Continue on a leisurely stroll through the Kroepeliner Strasse and Am Neuen Markt and explore the quaint shopping streets,

which have flourished since the reunification of East and West Germany in 1990.

You'll see the 15th century Town Hall with its 18th century Baroque front structure, and St. Mary's church built around 1398. Enjoy a guided tour of this church before spending some time at your leisure (strictly time permitting). After reuniting with your guide, walk down to the jetty to begin a relaxing cruise along the Warnow River, transferring you back to the ship. During your approximate 50 minute cruise, you'll be served some typical snacks and refreshing drinks or German beer.

## PICTURESQUE VIEWS & THE MOLLI TRAIN

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_31

Depart the pier for Bad Doberan, a former summer residence of the Dukes of Mecklenburg and home to a grand example of Gothic red brick architecture. Enjoy a visit into the Minster, which was built between 1294 and 1368 and used to be a mighty Cistercian convent. It is home to one of Germany's earliest winged altars and also exhibits the earliest wood carved Madonna statue in northern Germany dating back to 1290. Transfer to a tiny train station and board the 'Molli', a narrow gauge steam train, for a leisurely 15-20 minute journey from Bad Doberan to Heiligendamm, 'chugging' at an approximate speed of 35 km per hour.

Pass along Europe's longest linden tree avenue, also referred to as the 'green tunnel'. Board your coach for a brief ride to Kuehlungsborn, where your guide will take you onto one of the sea bridges which are very popular to these old resorts, before you get the opportunity to stroll through the town center on your own or treat yourself to a short walk along the beach promenade. Board your coach again for a short transfer to your refreshment venue where you'll enjoy some coffee and traditional German cake.

Note: The order of the sights may vary. The Molli steam train route may alternate, depending on the day of operation. This tour is only offered on Norwegian Star August 27th, 2016 sailing.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF ROSTOCK & MECKLENBURG

Berlin (Rostock), Germany Tour Code: RSK\_30

Depart the pier in the late morning for an approximate 2 1/2-hour scenic coach tour that covers the main

attractions within the Rostock area. Upon arrival in Rostock's center, you'll see its century's old red-brick architecture, experience the local Hanseatic ambience, pass the old 'New Market' with its beautiful City Hall and St. Mary's Church – Rostock's famous landmark.

Continue past ruins of the old city walls and a former STASI prison (State Security of former East Germany) before continuing into the countryside. You'll pass by the Bad Doberan Cathedral, one of northern Germany's largest and mightiest medieval churches that towers above the rest of the village and nearby fields. From here you'll continue through small villages and past the typical Eastern Block living quarters of the area before returning to your ship. This is a perfect tour for guests with walking difficulties.
