BEST OF DALMATIA - SIBENIK, FLAVORS & TRADITIONS

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_08

Beautiful landscapes, rich cultural and historical monuments await you on the Sibenik Riviera. You'll visit the charming town of Sibenik, meet the locals in the village of Burni and sample a traditional Dalmatian meal.

Sibenik was founded by the Croats more than a thousand years ago. Its well preserved historical center and many of its grand monuments have earned the town, high marks in Croatian construction heritage. Follow your guide through its narrow streets leading to attractive squares where you'll find modern shop windows intertwined with the classic architecture of centuries gone by. Visit the Cathedral of St. Jacob – a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an important architectural monument. Walk past the City Hall, the baroque Orthodox Church, as well as the historic center with its cobbled streets, commercial and crafts center.

Drive inland to the Primosten area and the small picturesque village of Burni, passing interesting landscapes. You'll be impressed with the ingenuity of the people of this area, who transformed this rocky terrain into an oasis of fertile, hospitable living. Acquaint yourself, with a typical Dalmatian village, its inhabitants and traditions. After visiting some of the village homes, your hosts dressed in national costume will treat you to an authentic lunch and entertain you with local songs and music to complete your genuine Dalmatian experience.

Note: We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes and use adequate sun protection. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1/4 mile over cobblestone and gravel surfaces with numerous steps in Sibenik.

SPLIT & DIOCLETIAN PALACE

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_05

Experience a unique blend of old and new cultures and architecture during this full day excursion to Split and the Diocletian Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

A scenic drive of approximately 2 hours takes you to Split. Today's city is the product of 17 centuries of building, renovating and remodeling that has produced an eclectic blend of old and new. In the heart of this sprawling cityscape you'll find a spectacular Roman palace, built by Emperor Diocletian at the turn of the 4th century. Built as an imperial residence and fortress, today you'll find an intriguing labyrinth of narrow cobblestone streets, where pre-Romanesque churches stand next to Gothic chapels, museums, art galleries, restaurants and cafes.

The Old Town of Split surrounds the Diocletian Palace, and you'll follow your guide on a stroll through the palace's

well-preserved cellars, which offer a unique insight into palace life. Outside the palace, you'll see magnificent structures like the Golden Gate, Silver Gate, Peristyle Square and more. If time permits, you'll have some free time for independent exploration before lunch at a restaurant near the Diocletian Palace.

Note: We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes and use adequate sun protection. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1 1/4 miles over cobblestone surfaces with approximately 30 steps.

KRKA NATIONAL PARK

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_06

Immerse yourself in nature and enjoy magnificent views through the karst Sibenik home to the beautiful Krka River waterfalls. Located in Krka National Park, the falls form 17 natural cascades providing a spectacular display of nature's creativeness. This is one of seven national parks in Croatia and it covers an area of over 35,000 acres. This region is rich with endemic species - vegetation, as well as birds and fish. Due to very strong laws on natural preservation, this extraordinary area has been preserved in its original form.

You'll see the most attractive part of the park – the Skradinski Buk waterfalls. The highest fall is approximately 151 feet (46 meters) high, which makes it the highest gypsum barrier in Europe. Above the falls there is a large plateau that offers spectacular views and a perfect photo opportunity. You'll also have a chance to visit the small ethnological exhibition and the old mill which still functions today. Around the falls there is a path for you to explore further independently.

Note: Walking is at the guests' discretion during free time and over varying terrain, inclines and approximately 100 or more steps. We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable sturdy shoes and use adequate sun protection. Tour not recommended for guests with walkers or wheelchairs.

PAKLENICA NATIONAL PARK HIKE

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_03

Embrace the pristine natural beauty of Paklenica National Park during this scenic and invigorating hiking excursion. Drive to Starigrad Paklenica, a picturesque town and harbor located on the southern part of Velebit Mountain and continue to Paklenica National Park. It spans approximately 37 square miles (95 square km), and is highlighted by a legendary peak, Anica Kuk, on its 1,312-foot (400-metre) face. Its summit offers spectacular vistas of the coast, sea, Paklenica and the peaks of Velebit Mountain.

The park also features a pair of picturesque canyons, Mala (Small) and Velika (Large) Paklenica. Its defining characteristic is the steep drop from Anica Luka. The karst is an area of exceptional natural beauty and various geological formations. Cliffs, caves, holes and cracks abound and the dissolution of soluble rock has created natural works of art known as 'skraps'.

After receiving safety instructions, begin your guided hike through Paklenica's Karst River Canyon, located in the foreground of the magnificent Velika and Mala Paklenica canyons. Your hike winds through the river canyon uphill towards Anica Luka, with a few stops en route to admire the landscape and catch your breath. Once at Anica Luka, stop for refreshments, snacks and panoramic views of your surroundings. Afterward, commence the 1.5 hour return walk back to the valley.

Note: Participants must be in good physical condition with no back pain or heart problems, be at least 12 years of age and weigh no more than 220 lbs. (100 k). There is strenuous amount of walking over uneven and uphill terrain. We recommend comfortable sturdy shoes, sports clothing and adequate sun protection.

PAKLENICA NATIONAL PARK CAVING ADVENTURE

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_02

For the adventurous traveler, we offer an opportunity to explore the extreme splendor of nature and her expert geological craftsmanship. Immerse yourself in an underworld of beauty.

Paklenica National Park is an area of exceptional natural beauty and various geological formations where cliffs, caves, holes and cracks are numerous and where drops of water created examples of pure works of natural art.

Explore Modric Cave, in the vicinity of the park, it was discovered in the early eighties and opened to visitors in 2004. This is not a typical attraction but a true, natural cave for you to explore. There are no steps, paths or lighting inside, just the natural cave. Therefore, you'll need to wear the provided overalls and helmet with a carbide lamp.

Follow your professional guide through the halls, narrow corridors and gaps of the 920 yards (840 meters) long cave filled with stunning stalactites and stalagmites created over millions of years ago. Your guide will provide you with an insight into the power of nature and her artistic flair for unique beauty. Following this underworld adventure, relax and enjoy some refreshments with your fellow explorers.

Note: Participants must be in good physical condition with no back pain or heart problems, and be a minimum of 18 years of age and weigh no more than 220 lbs. (100 k) as there is strenuous activity on this tour. Participants are provided protective overalls and helmets with lamps and must follow strict ecological guidelines. Comfortable sturdy shoes, sports clothing and adequate sun protection are recommended. Tour is not recommended for guests suffering from claustrophobia. The temperature inside the cave stays a constant 55° F (13° C).

PANORAMAS & TASTES OF DALMATIA

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_04

Magnificent views of the Adriatic Coast, Zadar's countryside and local flavors are the highlights of this mostly panoramic tour. On your scenic drive along the coast, you'll pass picturesque villages and islands as you head to the Banovi Dvori family farm in the village of Dubrava. This farm and old village home is 150 years old - the owners work the land producing olive oil and products typical of this area. After visiting this rural estate you'll have the opportunity to enjoy a glass of wine and local produced specialties such as smoked ham, cheese and freshly baked bread.

Along the road, you'll stop to admire the views from Odmoriste Krk, one of the most attractive rest areas on the Adriatic Coast. It is situated on the left of the river Krka where the bridge connects two banks, on the rocks from which a beautiful view extends over Lake Prokljan, the river Krka and the town of Skradin. Surrounding the rest area are fields of plants, lavender, rosemary, sage and hundred year old olive trees.

Note: We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes and use adequate sun protection. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1/4 mile over cobblestone surfaces.

DALMATIAN TRADITIONS & ZADAR ORIENTATION

Learn the secrets of making Dalmatian prosciutto, enjoy a taste at the old tavern and discover the historic town of Zadar. A bus drive along the scenic Adriatic Coast takes you to the village of Stankovci. Visit the House of Dalmatian Prosciutto located in a beautiful old building among olive groves and vineyards. Watch and learn about the methods and specifics of producing this gastronomic delight. Enjoy snacks at the old tavern here and you'll even be able buy the products, right where they're produced.

Zadar's Old Town is located in a small peninsula surrounded by small islands. It's full of architectural treasures, which span some 2,000 year. Between Renaissance, Baroque and Medieval architecture, you'll find signs of modernity too. Visiting Zadar is like peeling back layers of time. Enjoy an orientation walking tour, followed by free time to explore on your own.

Note: We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes and use adequate sun protection. Guests must be able to walk approximately 3/4 mile over gravel and cobblestone surfaces with approximately 5-10 steps.

HIGHLIGHTS OF ZADAR

Zadar, Croatia Tour Code: ZAD_09

Discover one of the Adriatic's most interesting cities, where the old fashion way of living and new modern life, coexist in perfect harmony. Follow your guide through the picturesque streets of Zadar's historic center and see its treasures.

The Zadar area was first settled in the Neolithic period and since then, it has succumbed to numerous invasions from different civilizations. They have all left architectural traces of different periods and styles, which has resulted in an eclectic mix of architectural treasures. Cafés, bars, museums and churches have been restored and you can now take advantage of what this lovely city offers.

Your walking tour begins in the heart of the magnificent Old Town and includes a visit to the Cathedral of St. Anastasia, the finest example of Romanesque architecture in Zadar. Along the way you'll pass the Church of St. Donatus, believed to have been built by Bishop Donatus on Roman foundations at the beginning of the 9th century. See St. Mary's Church with a Romanesque bell-tower built at the beginning of the 12th century by the Hungarian – Croatian King Koloman. You'll see many treasures along the way. Enjoy some free time to further explore on your own, do some shopping or sip a coffee or glass of wine at a café.

Note: We recommend that you dress in layers, wear comfortable shoes and use adequate sun protection. Guests must be able to walk approximately 1/2 mile over cobblestone surfaces with approximately 20 steps.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 1 Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 2 Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.

ACTIVITY LEVEL 3 Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
