Adelaide's Gardens & Museums

This tour showcases Adelaide's historic architecture and colorful flora as you travel the city's grid pattern of wide streets and spacious squares surrounded by parkland.

Stop at **Montefiore Hill** to see **Light's Vision**—the statue of the city's founder, William Light. Admire the spectacular views across the parklands, the Torrens River and the Adelaide Hills. Continue into the **city center**, passing the Festival Centre, the Adelaide Casino and many elegant mansions.

A highlight of your tour is a visit to the **Bicentennial Conservatory** at the **Adelaide Botanic Garden**. The conservatory is located in the tropical rain forest section of the garden, and is

awash with waterfalls and rock pools. It was built to celebrate Australia's bicentenary (1988) and is the largest single-span conservatory in the Southern Hemisphere, housing a display of lowland tropical rain forest plants from Northern Australia, Papua New Guinea, Indonesia and the nearby Pacific Islands. Many of these plants are at risk or are endangered in their natural habitats.

Visit the **Palm House**, established in 1875—the pre-cursor to the Conservatory. It fully restored in 1992 and is believed to be the only one still in existence today.

Enjoy a guided tour of the **South Australian Museum** to view the extensive gallery dedicated to the history of Aboriginal culture. The museum features six floors of exhibits that reveal fascinating stories and reflect the museum's Australian Aboriginal and Pacific collections.

Central Market Tasting

Located in the heart of the Adelaide central business district, this melting pot of cultures is home to more than 80 food stalls for every type of produce, seafood, meat and ethnic cuisine that South Australians dearly love. An epicenter of food, culture and lifestyle, it is the largest fresh produce market in the Southern Hemisphere.

Transfer to the 140-year-old market and let the adventure begin!

Get the inside story about the famous food market, with generous **tastings** and delicious samples of the best in South Australian produce—olive oil, oysters, cheese and more.

Even the gastronomically challenged will enjoy the experience of this sensory and interactive **gourmet walking tour** guided by a local food expert.

Enjoy a coffee, visit the many stallholders and learn about the produce with some **free time** to explore or purchase goods (time permitting).

Cleland Wildlife Park is situated in the rolling hills of Adelaide's Mount Lofty Ranges. The park is where people and animals meet, and is home to a large collection of native Australian animals and birds. Set in 172 acres of picturesque bushland, it is where kangaroos, wallabies and emus run free.

Cuddle the koalas, see lakes for the waterfowl, and walk through aviaries and enclosures for dingos, Tasmanian devils, goanna, small mammals, and reptiles.

Have your photo taken with Australia's best-loved animal--the koala (at your own expense).

Your tour returns to Adelaide with wonderful views over the gulf waters, the city and the Adelaide Plains.

Hahndorf & the Adelaide Hills

Depart Port Adelaide for a brief **panoramic drive** past the city's sights, passing Government House, the University of South Australia, the Botanic Gardens and St Peter's Cathedral. Head up Mt Lofty for panoramic views over Adelaide. Continue to the Adelaide Hills—an area of unique charm with winding roads and quaint villages. Old-fashioned pubs, coffee houses and wineries showcase typical Australian hospitality here.

Visit the German town of **Hahndorf**. Settled in 1839 by Prussian and East German immigrants, Hahndorf is Australia's oldest surviving German settlement. The German influence is still visible today in the architecture of the old buildings, many of which still serve as homes and shops. The Pioneer Gardens in the main street have memorials to Hahn and other settler families.

An old windmill (1842) has been fully restored, and there are several 19th-century churches. Storison's **souvenir shop** was once the blacksmith's shop (1870) and the **Hahndorf Academy** (1871) is now an Art Gallery featuring the talents of legendary Australian artist, Sir Hans Heysen.

Stroll under the cork elm trees along the town's shady, century-old main street.

Watch for the quaint cottages displaying interesting wares and local crafts such as pottery, jewelry, leather crafts and ironwork.

During your **free time** you may choose to learn the history of the area from the knowledgeable docents at the Hahndorf Academy (optional, at your own expense).

A scenic 90-minute drive through the rugged Adelaide Hills will bring you to the **Barossa Valley**—Australia’s foremost wine-producing region. With more than 150 years of viticultural involvement, the Barossa Valley is home to around 50 wineries.

Explore the riches of the valley, enjoying the fruits of the vine along the way.

Stop at **four of the valley’s boutique wineries**, teasing the palate with a selection of single-grape and blended wine styles. Tours, **tastings**, and an opportunity to purchase the wines you have enjoyed are the highlights of the day.

Watch for landmarks such as Bethany—an old German settlement in South Australia, the old Barossa goldfields, and the town of Tanunda.

A gourmet two-course **lunch** with a glass of local **wine** will be served at a renowned winery restaurant.
