## Tour Descriptions for Lima (Callao), Peru

### BEST OF LIMA - TREASURES, TEMPLES & HORSES

Lima (Callao), Peru Tour Code: CLL\_02

Begin with a drive through the Pueblo Libre district to the National Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology, which exhibits evidence of all cultures of pre-Columbian civilizations. Drive through the residential districts of San Isidro and Miraflores to take the Pan-American Highway towards the Pachacamac Pilgrimage Center, built by a pre-Incan civilization around 700 A.D. as a temple of the Sun God. Traces remain of vivid frescoes that decorated the interior, and evidence shows that doors were elaborately inlaid with turquoise, coral and rock crystal.

Located in an extremely arid climate, the adobe buildings remained in good condition until a freak storm in the 1920s caused massive erosion. Still impressive, these ruins evoke vivid images of the people and culture that once inhabited them. Head to one of the most important Peruvian Paso horse breeder ranches in the country, where you'll learn about these stepping horses. Watch an exhibition by some of these champion equines, each adorned in handcrafted leather and silver, and feast on a delicious country lunch prepared in traditional Pachamanca-style, while enjoying a folkloric performance.

### EXCLUSIVE TREASURES OF COLONIAL LIMA

Lima (Callao), Peru Tour Code: CLL\_20

Discover the hidden treasures of Lima in the company of a small group and enjoy Peruvian cuisine specialties in one of the most beautiful colonial mansions of the city center. Drive to the historical district of Rimac, where you'll see the beautiful colonial buildings of Paseo de Aguas and Alameda de los Descalzos.

Head downtown to visit the Jesuit Temple of San Pedro, a jewel of Peruvian Baroque. Drive to the San Marcos University, founded in 1551 and the first university in South America. During the visit, you'll learn about its fascinating history.

Proceed to Casa Aliaga, America's best-preserved colonial mansion which has been occupied by the same family since 1535. The land was given to Captain de Aliaga by Pizarro himself, here he built the ancestral house that has been home to approximately seventeen generations. The artistic and historical value of the mansion is priceless as you'll see while you visit its spacious and beautifully decorated rooms. A typical Peruvian gourmet lunch complements your visit.

## PILGRIMAGE TO PACHACAMAC WITH AN EXPERT

Lima (Callao), Peru Tour Code: CLL\_24

Pachacamac, which means 'the One who ordains the Universe,' is the most ancient Andean Pilgrimage Center in America. As early as 700 A.D., pilgrims came here to consult the oracle. Pachacamac allowed the nobles and the peasants to see both the past and future. This archaeological center conserves the mysticism and religiosity of its past.

Walking through this site one can feel the magic attraction of a place that will always be sacred. Accompanied by a researcher of Andean myths and cosmic energy, you'll learn how to recognize the subtle energies present here, as well as equilibrate and cleanse your electromagnetic camp.

## PERUVIAN GEMS – LARCO & GOLD MUSEUMS

Lima (Callao), Peru Tour Code: CLL\_21

Archaeologists are still accumulating evidence that represents all of the many ancient cultures of Peru, their relationships to each other and the reasons for their decline from power. Today you'll visit two of Lima's outstanding museums which will acquaint you with some of these cultures. Drive through residential districts of Lima to visit the renowned Gold Museum, containing a dazzling collection of pre-Inca and Inca gold jewelry and ceremonial objects. Admire its priceless pre-Columbian gold artifacts such as the very interesting golden mask from the Lambayeque culture.

The museum also houses an extensive exhibition of army weapons and uniforms, with some 10,000 weapons of the 15th and 16th Century. Visit the Rafael Larco Herrera Museum, housed in an 18th-century colonial mansion. Its immense and invaluable collection of pottery has been assembled from all of the known Peruvian cultures. There is a small cactus garden, and a separate room with an extensive collection of erotic pottery art. An exhibit of textiles made from feathers, and a Paracas weaving that contains 398 threads to the linear inch – possibly a world record – rounds out this collection.

## LARCO MUSEUM & PERUVIAN FLAVORS

Lima (Callao), Peru Tour Code: CLL\_05

Connect with Peru's fascinating past at the Larco Herrera Museum, the private collection of Rafael Larco Hoyle, a pioneer of Peruvian archaeology and research. This stimulating and inspiring space includes more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history in its different exhibit rooms. It contains beautiful examples of textile work, one of which has a world record-breaking 398 threads per inch, as well as the tools ancient Peruvians used to produce metals, ceramics and gold and silver pieces with semiprecious stones.

One of the galleries houses a collection of erotic ceramics that expresses the rituals and intimate relationship that these societies had with nature. At the end of the tour, enjoy a traditional Pisco Sour accompanied by typical snacks at the museum's cafe. You'll also have a few minutes to browse or shop at the museum's store.
