## **Tour Descriptions for Puerto Chiapas, Mexico**

#### **IZAPA RUINS & CHOCOLATE DISCOVERY**

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD\_05

Take a journey for approximately 45 minutes to the ancient ruins of Izapa. From its beginning as a small village, Izapa grew into the region's most influential cultural and commercial center with a population of possibly up to 10,000 people. Izapa brought together many of Mesoamerica's ancient cultures and many believe it may be the site of origin of the sacred Mayan Calendar; although, much study remains to be done in order to unlock these secrets.

Travel by bus to the Chocolate Discovery, where you'll be able to watch how the cocoa beans are transformed into chocolate right at the main square. Also, you'll sample the local cuisine, as well as see a variety of local handcrafts and exotic flowers of the region. Local dances and marimba players will be sharing their skills with lively performances. After a stop at the local historic church, you'll be on your way back to your ship.

Note: Guests should wear a hat and comfortable shoes. Bring eco-friendly sunscreen and bug repellent. Most areas are not wheelchair accessible.

#### **BANANA FARM & RURAL COMMUNITY**

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD 01

Take a journey into the heart of rural Chiapas for a deeper understanding of the local people and landscapes. Discover the culture that blends ancient traditions with modern necessity. Board your air-conditioned bus and travel through the Chiapas countryside to the Ejido Miguel Aleman Banana Farm. Your guide will acquaint you with the history of the region, its people and traditions, as well as the growing and collection process of the bananas.

Then, travel into the town that owns and runs the banana cooperative and visit the local community center or school - here, you'll meet and mingle with the local children, the dedicated teachers and social workers. You'll be able to donate a kit pack to one of the kids at the community center or local school. The kit pack contains some of their basic day to day needs. Continue to the Banana Packing Plant, where you'll discover how the whole community works together to pack the bananas they all produce. On the way back, you'll get a last glimpse of life in rural Chiapas before returning to the pier.

Note: Guests should wear a hat and comfortable shoes. Bring eco-friendly sunscreen and bug repellent. Part of the proceeds of this tour will go to the community center learning program. Most areas are not wheelchair accessible.

Experience the sounds, flavors and culture of Mexico in this culinary tour. Take a short walk from your ship to a local restaurant located at the pier. Upon arrival, you'll be welcomed with a freshly made Margarita. Then you'll be greeted by the chef who will show you how to prepare some local dishes. At the end of your cooking class, you'll be served a meal consisting of dishes similar to those you just learned to prepare, while the Marimba players' lively performance enhances your Mexican experience. You'll be able to take home a copy of the recipe you prepared.

### CHIAPAS THROUGH THE AGES

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD\_04

Experience Mexico's past and present as you explore the ancient Mayan archaeological site of Izapa, visit the planetarium and learn about Mayan cosmology, watch Maya dancers perform and then wander through Tapachula's town square on a tour that will both educate and delight you.

You'll take an approximately 45-minute bus ride to the ancient ruins of Izapa. From its beginnings as a small village around 1500 B.C., Izapa grew into the region's most influential cultural and commercial center with an estimated population of about 10,000 at its peak. It was believed to be site where the sacred Mayan calendar originated and the leader in the region's production of the highly valued cacao. Upon arrival, take a guided tour of the main buildings and learn about the history and enjoy some free time to explore on your own.

From here, you'll travel by bus to the culturally diverse city of Tapachula whose history and heritage has been influenced not only by the Mayans, Mestizo and Spanish but by German, Chinese, Japanese and French immigrants as well. Your tour guide will introduce you to some the city's highlights during a short walking tour around the town square. You'll have free time for shopping in local artisan shops for leather goods, ceramics and more. Continue to Tapachula's Planetarium for a presentation inside the dome about Mayan astronomy and cosmology and watch Mayan dancers perform, before returning by bus to your ship.

### **CHOCOLATE DISCOVERY TRANSFER**

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD\_07

Explore one of the most interesting Mayan sites in the region, a collection of ancient stone carvings dating from roughly 300 BCE to 100 BCE. These carvings depict the Mayan ideas of the creation of the universe and their religious beliefs. The Tree of Life in the Mayan world is a Ceiba tree, commonly found in Chiapas and the Mayan jungles.

Take a short bus ride to the Chocolate Discovery. Here, you'll learn about the discovery and history of the sacred cacao bean and its importance to the Mayan people. See how the beans are transformed into chocolate right in the main square. Also, you'll see a variety of local handcrafts and flowers of the region. Local dancers and marimba players will provide a lively performance. After a short stop to see the local church, you'll be on your way back to your ship.

Note: Guests should wear a hat and comfortable shoes. Bring eco-friendly sunscreen and bug repellent. Most areas are not wheelchair accessible.

#### **ARGOVIA COFFEE TASTING & BOTANICAL GARDEN**

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD 03

Discover the world's finest coffee at Argovia Plantation and Estate. Founded in 1880, Argovia is one the oldest coffee producers in the region and a one-of-a-kind, family owned agricultural estate. Travel by air-conditioned van for approximately 90 minutes through the lush forests and breathtaking scenery of the Sierra Madre Mountains to the plantation.

Your guide will provide in-depth information about the history of the area and its people. Take a short tour of the grounds and learn about the Plantation's history as well as the history of coffee. Then, discover all the flavors that distinguish Chiapas coffee. Practice observing the tastes and aromas of brewed coffee, learn the art of coffee tasting and why it's 'ok' to slurp! Take a tour of the flower plantation and see these extraordinary specimens of nature's gifts. Get to know all the diversity of foliage, tropical and exotic flowers, in one small and spectacular botanical garden. Afterwards, browse the gift shop where you can purchase Argovia's famous coffee to take home with you.

Puerto Chiapas, Mexico Tour Code: PMD 10



Upon arrival, you'll be given a complimentary drink along with a safety briefing before your hiking adventure. Follow your guide through a slow paced walk while observing different kinds of exotic flowers, small fauna and the forest that surrounds you. Also, enjoy a scenic view of the Tacana Volcano which marks the border between Mexico and Guatemala. After your hiking journey, enjoy a snack, taste some coffee or shop at the local stores before returning to your ship.
