Tour Descriptions for Puerto Madryn, Argentina

GREAT PATAGONIAN ADVENTURE

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_00

Enjoy this adventure and nature experience in Patagonia. You'll spend time at a penguin reserve, see wildlife and enjoy a lunch of roasted Patagonian lamb in the rustic setting of Estancia San Lorenzo.

Peninsula Valdez is one of the finest wildlife reserves in South America and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It provides an outstanding natural habitat for sea lions, sea elephants, seals and birds. Enjoy a brief stop at the small Visitors Center to view exhibits on the flora and fauna and drive to Punta Norte to see a colony of sea lions and elephant seals.

Visit Estancia San Lorenzo, home to a huge penguin rookery. Here you'll transfer to Golfo San Matias by 4x4 vehicle to see a large colony of Magellanic penguins. You'll have time to observe them, learn about their habits and take photographs. You might even encounter other wildlife here. Enjoy a hearty lunch at the estancia, before or after your penguin experience.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over uneven, cobblestone, sand, steep terrain and 30 steps. Buses may not be air-conditioned and travel along bumpy, dusty roads. Although wildlife sightings are frequent, they are not guaranteed. Do not get too close or touch wildlife.

ESTANCIA EXPERIENCE, PUNTA LOMA & ECOCENTRO

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_15

Travel to the scenic Estancia San Guillermo, a typical Patagonian ranch and get a glimpse of life in the vast countryside and stop for photos in Punta Loma, a breeding ground for sea lions.

Your hosts at Estancia San Guillermo welcome you to their 7,400-acre ranch for a unique experience. This sheep ranch is surrounded by endless open countryside. You'll see a wide variety of ranch animals and pets. In the sheep shed, sit down for presentation by the owners and their favorite household pets followed by a sheep shearing demonstration. Enjoy a tasty snack and free time to browse the souvenir shop.

Stop at Punta Loma Reserve and from the lookout point, you'll be able to see the permanent colony of sea lions lying on the rocks. The sea lions, when not sunning themselves on the beach, can be observed full of life in the water showing off their swimming skills. Visit EcoCentro, a cultural space that educates visitors through exhibits of Patagonian sea life. Be sure not to miss the whales' sensory experience and the interactive pools.

Note: Buses may not be air-conditioned and travel along bumpy, dusty roads.

PUNTA TOMBO PENGUIN ROOKERY

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_02

Discover Punta Tombo, home to the world's largest nesting colony of Magellanic penguins and a place that attracts wildlife researchers and conservationists from around the world.

This is the largest penguin nesting ground in continental South America and from September through April this vast rookery and breeding area hosts hundreds of thousands of Magellanic penguins. With two nurturing parents foraging at sea and taking turns with their care, chicks thrive and start fledging in January.

Magellanic penguins mate with the same partner year after year and live approximately 25 years. Males reclaim the burrow from the previous year and wait to reconnect with their mates. You'll have time to walk among the thousands of nests and marvel at this wonder of nature and these unforgettable birds. A boxed lunch is provided.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over uneven, cobblestone, sand, steep terrain and 20 steps. The 100 mile drive is approximately 2 1/2 hours each way. Buses may not be air-conditioned and travel along bumpy, dusty roads. Do not get too close or touch wildlife.

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_05

Discover Punta Tombo, home to the world's largest nesting colony of Magellanic penguins in the company of a small group and comfort of an air conditioned mini-bus.

This is the largest penguin nesting ground in continental South America and from September through April this vast rookery and breeding area hosts hundreds of thousands of Magellanic penguins. With two nurturing parents foraging at sea and taking turns with their care, chicks thrive and start fledging in January.

Magellanic penguins mate with the same partner year after year and live approximately 25 years. Males reclaim the burrow from the previous year and wait to reconnect with their mates. You'll have time to walk among the thousands of nests and marvel at this wonder of nature and these unforgettable birds. Enjoy lunch at the reserve's tea house.

PENINSULA VALDES WILDLIFE SANCTUARY

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_03

Peninsula Valdez is one of the finest wildlife reserves in South America and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It provides an outstanding natural habitat for sea lions, elephant seals, fur seals and a variety of birds. Enjoy a brief stop at the small Visitors Center to view exhibits on the flora and fauna of the Peninsula.

Visit Caleta Valdes on the eastern shore, a sheltered bay with a long gravel spit onto which elephant seals and others haul up in the spring. You'll spend some time here to watch the wildlife from a distance. Nearby, there may be a possibility to view a very small and new penguin colony. Stop to watch one of the peninsula's major sea lion colonies near Puerto Piramides. A boxed lunch is provided.

EXCLUSIVE PENINSULA VALDES

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_09

Explore Peninsula Valdes, one of the world's finest nature reserves and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, traveling in a small group and the comfort of an air conditioned mini-bus.

Peninsula Valdez is one of the finest wildlife reserves in South America and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It provides an outstanding natural habitat for sea lions, elephant seals, fur seals and a variety of birds. Enjoy a brief stop at the small Visitors Center to view exhibits on the flora and fauna of the Peninsula.

Visit Caleta Valdes on the eastern shore, a sheltered bay with a long gravel spit onto which elephant seals and others haul up in the spring. PATAGONIAN DINOSAURS & PUNTA LOMA RESERVE

Puerto Madryn, Argentina Tour Code: PMY_01

Discover the most important paleontology museum in South America and stop for photos at Punta Loma Reserve. Driving through the Patagonian plains, you'll arrive at Punta Loma Reserve. Here, from the lookout point, you'll be able to see the permanent colony of sea lions lying on the rocks. The sea lions, when not sunning themselves on the beach, can be observed full of life in the water showing off their swimming skills.

Visit the Museum of Paleontology in the Welch town of Trelew. It's the most important paleontology museum in South America and acclaimed worldwide. The museum features different species of dinosaurs, chronologically ordered, and each in a distinctive environment as well as other exhibits.

Your guided visit is rounded off by a documentary that is informative and entertaining.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over uneven, cobblestone, sand, steep terrain and 20 steps. Buses may not be air-conditioned and travel along bumpy, dusty roads.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
