## Tour Descriptions for Punta Arenas, Chile

### TORRES DEL PAINE NATIONAL PARK

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_02

Torres del Paine is one of the most spectacular scenic regions in the world and a major attraction in South America. At an altitude of 150 feet above sea level and a peak reaching 9,840 feet covered by perpetual snow, it offers an exciting adventure.

Transfer to the airport and after an approximately one hour charter flight, your plane will land in Puerto Natales. Board a motorcoach for an approximately 2 1/2 hours scenic drive to Torres del Paine National Park. You'll drive through rolling pampas, past shimmering lakes, cascading waterfalls, sprawling glaciers and dense forests with abundant wildlife. Approaching the park, you'll catch your first glimpse of the distinct peaks.

Established in 1959, the park was granted status as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1978. You'll stop at Lake Sarmiento for a view of the Paine Massif and make a photo stop at Laguna Amarga, a nature reserve. Drive to Nordenskjold Lake to admire the spires that gave the park its name, rising majestically across the lake.

At Salto Grande, stop for a photo opportunity at a waterfall and admire the striking natural beauty. Enjoy lunch at the Hostería Pehoe, the location of this rustic hotel offers a spectacular view of the Paine Massif towering above Lake Pehoe that never fails to awe visitors.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1 mile of walking over uneven terrain. Operation of this tour and park stops are subject to weather conditions. We recommend you bring a sweater and a light raincoat. Tour participation is limited but subject to a minimum number of participants. Aircraft used depends upon number of participants - it could be a 19 seat Twin Otter, a 9 seat Cessna - or similar depending upon aircraft availability.

### PATAGONIAN ESTANCIA EXPERIENCE

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_23

Enjoy Patagonian hospitality and an exciting day of country living at one of the most important local estancias. A scenic drive crossing the endless pampa (treeless grassland) brings you to this 100 year-old cattle ranch. It was established by sheep farmers in the middle of the vast Patagonian pampas and today, the estancia has opened its doors to a limited amount of visitors to demonstrate the art of living of these staunch farmers.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed by the hospitable, expert sheep farmers who have made this region famous, they will show you the different activities of the farm. You'll be amazed seeing machinery used by the first colonists of the area still in use, in addition to the well trained dogs. You'll be taken into the barn for a

demonstration of sheep shearing.

Try the traditional welcome drink, a Pisco Sour, as well as baked empanadas. Enjoy a barbecue of tasty Patagonian lamb, which has been grilled slowly for hours, accompanied by vegetables and salad. After lunch you'll have free time to enjoy the farm and getting to know more about the life of the inhabitants of the Patagonian pampas.

Note: Tour involves walking over uneven terrain and managing steps. Weather in Punta Arenas is unpredictable and most activities take place outdoors which can get rather chilly. We suggest you dress comfortably and warmly.

## FIRST SETTLER'S EXPERIENCE

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_04

Discover the charm of the most southerly city in the world, learn how the natives and the first European settlers lived in this rugged land, and enjoy typical Patagonian hospitality.

A sightseeing drive around this bustling frontier town introduces you to the capital of the Magallanes Region. See the main square and stop at Cerro la Cruz for panoramic views. Visit the Maggiorino Borgatello Museum, founded by the Salesian missionaries, it provides a comprehensive overview of the regional flora and fauna, the habitat of the indigenous people of the region and local history. You'll see Pioneer Cemetery, lined by tall cypresses and grand mausoleums and the burial place of the last, now extinct Ona Indians.

Head south on a very scenic road, skirting the Strait of Magellan to Fort Bulnes, the first Chilean settlement in Patagonia, founded in 1843, with only 21 inhabitants. This reconstruction will show you how these men and women lived on this rugged land. You'll have sweeping views from the fort towards the Strait of Magellan. Enjoy a typical Patagonian lunch to complement your southernmost experience.

Note: Tour involves approximately 3/4 miles of walking and managing about 50 steps. Most explanations are written in Spanish only. Flash photography and videography are not permitted in the museum. Weather in Punta Arenas is unpredictable. Please dress in layers and bring a windbreaker or waterproof jacket.

## MAGDALENA ISLAND PENGUIN RESERVE

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_08

A privately chartered ferry boat takes you to one of Chile's largest penguin colonies. Located on Magdalena Island, the site was declared a natural monument in 1982. Board the ferry boat for an approximately two-hour journey along the Strait of Magellan.

You'll have about one hour on the island to observe the Magellan penguins in their natural habitat. A large colony of penguins nest and breed here, each year between October and March. They bury their eggs in sandy burrows and under shrubs; at this time of year most of the chicks will have hatched. They're naturally curious and untamed - if approached too quickly they will scamper off. Following ample time to observe the birds, you'll walk back to the ferry for your journey back to Punta Arenas. A boxed lunch is included.

Note: Walking is on mostly flat, marked pathways. Ferry ride may be rough depending upon sea and weather conditions. We recommend you bring a windbreaker and scarf and wear sturdy walking shoes. Please do not touch the penguins, as their bites can inflict serious wounds.

## TREKKING AT ANDINO PARK

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_06

Discover Patagonia, a place that brings images of windy and cold landscapes, and offers great views. First, drive to Club Andino (Andean Club), a unique ski center that is one of the very few in the world with a view to the ocean. It's also used in the summer and makes for great trekking on the slopes, which are covered with native trees.

Upon arrival at the club, get on a ski lift that covers a distance of approximately one mile, and offers a great view over the area. From the top of the hill, you'll see the Strait of Magellan and the city of Punta Arenas, in the distance. At the descent point, trek downhill on a path through the woods. At the end of your walk, take a few minutes to relax and have some refreshments.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Tour involves approximately 1 1/4 miles of walking over uneven terrain and managing 20 steps. The trek may be slippery and muddy, if raining. Activities are subject to weather conditions.

## KAYAKING THE STRAIT OF MAGELLAN


Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_22

Navigate the legendary Strait of Magellan on a two-person sea kayak. Transfer by motor coach approximately 17 miles south to the Agua Fresca Bay area. Upon arrival, you'll receive a short briefing on how to use your double kayak, how to paddle in tandem, along with safety instructions and a semi dry suit.

During this adventurous ride you'll experience direct contact with nature and water, navigate among local birds such as seagulls or ducks and you may even be joined by the friendly austral dolphins that seasonally migrate here. After approximately 1 hour of kayaking, refreshments will be served and you'll have a chance to change into your dry clothes before you return to the pier.

Note: Participants must be 12 years or older and know how to swim. The width of the kayak cockpit is only 17.5 inches (45 cm) wide, please take this into consideration. Tour is not suitable for guests with any physical limitations. Waiver must be signed and medical conditions disclosed.

A life vest is provided, along with a two-piece semi dry suit. Weather in Punta Arenas is unpredictable; we suggest you dress comfortably and warmly. Bring a warm hat, sun protection, and a change of clothes in case you get wet. Tour is subject to weather and sea conditions. In the event of strong winds or high waves, navigation will be reduced in time and distance.

## WALKING PUNTA ARENAS


Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_25

Explore Punta Arenas on foot and get closer to the locals. A walking tour is the best way to get to know a city and see it from a different perspective. Punta Arenas is a city of hard-working immigrants who have struggled against the harsh nature of this southerly, end-of-the-world land. You'll visit some of the houses that they have inhabited and enjoy the calm music that has comforted them.

Your walk begins at the pier, covering the distance between the port area and the regional museum. Visit the Braun-Menendez Mansion, a national monument designed and built by the renowned French architect Antoine Beaulier in 1906. The mansion is a well preserved example of how affluent families lived at the turn of the century and contains all of its original furniture, decor and memorabilia.

Visit the Plaza de Armas, the main square surrounded by buildings that remind us of the glorious past of the city. Just across the street is the Union Club, the most exclusive club in town, sharing the same building as Hotel Jose Nogueira. Here, enjoy tea and snacks while listening to a classical music performance.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over uneven and steep terrain with about 40 steps to manage.

## PUNTA ARENAS HIGHLIGHTS

Punta Arenas, Chile Tour Code: PUQ\_20

Discover the charm of Punta Arenas on this comprehensive city tour. Drive through the main square, Plaza de Armas, to Cerro La Cruz for a panoramic view over the city, the Magellan Strait and the legendary Tierra del Fuego Island. Your guide will offer an explanation of the Magallanes region. Continue to the Maggiorino Borgatello Museum, founded by Salesian missionaries and noted for excellent exhibits illustrating the habitat and history of Patagonia's Aboriginal people, as well as the region's natural history.

Stop at the open-air Patagonian Institute depicting pioneer life with a collection of antique trains, machinery and other items from the Colonial period. You'll also visit Pioneer Cemetery, lined by tall cypresses and grand mausoleums and the burial place of the last now extinct Ona Indians.

Note: Tour involves approximately 1/2 mile of walking over even and paved terrain and about 50 steps to manage. At the museum, you must climb a flight of stairs to reach some of the displays, and most explanations are written in Spanish only. Weather in Punta Arenas is unpredictable. Please dress in layers and bring a windbreaker or waterproof jacket.

## Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
