Tour Descriptions for Punta del Este, Uruguay

URUGUAYAN COUNTRYSIDE & OLIVE OIL EXPERIENCE

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_04

On your scenic drive through the Uruguayan countryside you might see some wildlife, and beautiful birds that nest in Uruguay in the summer. Upon arrival at the boutique olive oil plant, you'll watch a DVD highlighting the origin and culture of olive oil, followed by a visit of the state of the art facilities where the oil is produced and packed. After the plant's visit, you'll enjoy an olive oil and wine tasting, accompanied by cheese and homemade bread.

Note: Tour involves approximately 546yd/500m of walking over flat, uneven terrain and dirt surfaces.

INDIGENA RESERVE NATURE ENCOUNTER

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_06

Discover an amazing world of nature when you visit the Indigena Nature Reserve. You'll encounter animals in their natural habitat as well as native fauna and flora.

Indigena is a private nature reserve on over 300 acres. You'll be guided by a park ranger on a walk through three very different ecosystems - grasslands, native forests and wetlands. Learn about native Uruguayan flora and fauna, enjoying new scents, textures and flavors. Experience the excitement of seeing animals such as rheas and capybaras in their natural habitat and where approximately 145 species of birds been sighted and recorded.

Walk through the wetlands on a trail with a low level of difficulty and enter a special microclimate at the native forest. A short hike then leads you to the grasslands, for a magnificent view of the countryside and hills. Visit the Native Plant Nursery and greenhouse where you'll also enjoy some original wooden sculptures. After your enjoyable walk you'll be invited to taste local treats at a picnic area in the woods.

Note: Tour involves approximately 2mi/2.5km of walking over uneven and even surfaces.

PUNTA DEL ESTE, CASAPUEBLO & RALLI MUSEUM

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_02

Take a scenic drive through Punta del Este's most fashionable and impressive neighborhoods. Visit Casapueblo with its surrealistic architecture and magnificent views. Admire the works of art housed at the Ralli Museum of Contemporary Art. This upscale resort is often compared to some resorts of the French Riviera but despite its jet-set appeal, here you'll encounter charm, great vistas and friendly people.

Drive through the residential areas of Cantegril, San Rafael, Parque Golf and La Barra de Maldonado, known for its unique hanging undulated bridges. Visit the Ralli Museum of Contemporary Art with its fine collection of paintings and sculptures by noted Latin American artists, including several Salvador Dali pieces on permanent display.

Stop at Punta Ballena for sweeping panoramic views up and down the coast before ending your drive at Casapueblo, home of late renowned artist, Carlos Paez Vilaro. The dazzling white complex, resembles Spanish-Moroccan architecture and is located on a bluff overlooking the ocean. Vilaro built it in 1958 with his own hands, using only traditional tools.

Note: Tour involves approximately 492yd/450m of walking on mostly flat surfaces and 30 steps. Photographs and video recordings are not permitted in the museum.

PUNTA DEL ESTE & ITS ARTISTIC EDGE

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_03

Join a scenic drive through Punta del Este's most interesting beaches and neighborhoods and discover two unique and very interesting art collections. The treasure trove of art and architecture hidden here is a well-kept secret, known only to a select few.

Punta del Este is known as a world class resort and jet-set destination. Driving from the harbor you'll see the Peninsula Brava Beach and the open air collection of sculptures at Square of the Americas, among which The Hand is a city icon. Pass through the residential areas of San Rafael, Golf Park and Beverly Hills before arriving to the Ralli Museum. Located in the emerald green setting of Beverly Hills, the museum houses a collection of works by Latin American painters and sculptors, as well as European artists such as Salvador Dali.

Visit the Pablo Atchugarry Foundation where you'll admire some impressive marble sculptures among other works of art. This nonprofit organization has created a space of ideal union between art and nature. During your visit, you'll see the artist's workshop, exhibition halls, and a permanent collection and works of Pablo Atchugarry.

Note: Tour involves approximately 656yd/600m of walking on mostly flat surfaces, grass and 15 steps. Photographs and video recordings are not allowed inside Ralli Museum.

PUNTA DEL ESTE BY BIKE

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_05

Punta del Este's well-kept gardens and beautiful beaches provide a perfect location for a leisurely bicycle ride. Enjoy the sights as your ride around this famous peninsula's promenade and beaches. You'll be guided along safe paths and visit Mansa Beach, where sea lions can often be seen. You'll also see the city's symbolic lighthouse, dating back to 1860.

Another highlight, is the Church of Our Lady of the Candelaria, a beautiful sky-blue-and-white Victorian structure as well as Four Seas point, Punta Salina - where a battle between German and British ships took place in 1939. You'll also see English Beach, Emir Beach, Punta Vapor and the famous monument known as The Hand. You'll make stops along the way to allow for photo opportunities.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and weigh no more than 200 pounds. Bike ride covers a distance of approximately 5mi/8km on paved and unpaved flat surfaces. A helmet is provided. A signed waiver is required.

PUNTA DEL ESTE SIGHTS & LEISURE

Punta del Este, Uruguay Tour Code: PDP_01

Sit back and relax with on an orientation drive of famous Punta del Este peninsula, with free time for shopping or to unwind at the beach. This resort town is often compared to some on the French Riviera thanks to its endless beaches and upscale resorts. But despite its jet-set reputation, you'll find plenty of charm, great vistas and friendly people.

Drive through the area's most fashionable and impressive neighborhoods. Pass through the residential areas of Cantegril, San Rafael, and Parque Golf among others. Your drive takes you past some of the beaches, stopping at Punta Ballena for sweeping panoramic views up and down the coast. Then return to Punta del Este where you'll enjoy approximately 1 1/2 hours free time at Avenida Gorlero's trendy shopping area. You can spend time shopping and people watching, or choose to enjoy one of the nearby beaches.

Note: Tour involves minimal amount of walking, although level of exertion during free time is entirely up to you.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
