Tour Descriptions for Stanley, Falkland Islands

LONG ISLAND FARM EXCURSION

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_20

Meet the Watson's at Long Island Farm, a 6th generation family owned sheep farm. Your hosts will demonstrate several traditional farming practices and treat you to tasty home baked treats in their kitchen.

Long Island is a 22,000-acre farm located approximately 20 miles from Stanley where the Watson's still farm in traditional Falkland style, using locally bred dogs and horses to gather their sheep. Learn about the history and use of peat for fuel here. Watch the skilled dogs herd the sheep, see a sheep shearing demonstration and learn about the horses work here on the farm. After, join Mrs. Watson in the kitchen for a delicious spread of home-baked cookies and savories served with tea and coffee.

There is a two-mile long white-sand beach teeming with shore birds directly in front of the house, and you are welcome to stroll anywhere around the farm and see the gardens, brimming with produce.

Note: Tour participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required for tour to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

THE LAGOON BLUFF

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_23

Travel to the Bluff Cove Lagoon on an off-road adventure to discover the penguin colony in this natural habitat. Visit the small museum and enjoy home-made goodies at the cozy café.

Start with a scenic 20-minute drive on mini-buses and transfer to 4x4 vehicles for an off road adventure with experienced local drivers. Upon arrival at the lagoon, you'll be met by rangers and will be able to wander around the penguin colony and along the sandy white beach at leisure. There are approximately 1,000 pairs of Gentoo penguins and a growing colony of King penguins here. The site is very photogenic with a large lagoon and long sand beach, home to a variety of seabirds. Sea lions and dolphins have been spotted here on occasion.

The Sea Cabbage Café offers comfortable, warm rooms, heated by a traditional peat stove. Here you can enjoy delicious home-made cakes, cookies, and scones with coffee or hot chocolate. The Bluff Cove Museum by the beach depicts life in the Falklands and tells the story of Bluff Cove. Visitors can find out about the farm, the wildlife here, and watch a demonstration of spinning and felting with local wool. There is a small gift shop offering unique souvenirs.

Note: Minimal walking is required, although some is on uneven terrain from the vehicles to the penguins. Tour is not recommended for those with neck, back problems or mobility challenges. Tour participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required for tour to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

SPARROW COVE PENGUIN ADVENTURE

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_25

With a backdrop of white sand beaches and craggy mountains, privately owned Sparrow Cove is an amazing location to visit a huge Gentoo penguin colony. Your adventure begins with a transfer from your ship by motor launch to board a 4x4 vehicle for your off-road journey to the penguin colony, with views of Stanley and of your ship at anchor along the way.

The Gentoo penguin colony has approximately 1,600 penguins, and occasionally, one or two pairs of King Penguins drop by. Friendly, knowledgeable wardens will greet and guide you around the penguin colonies, and answer your questions.

There is also the opportunity to see other wildlife, such as red-backed hawks and Falkland Skuas. An onsite cabin sells homemade cakes and cookies, coffee and tea, as well as locally crafted souvenirs.

Note: You'll walk approximately 100 yards/91 meters across rough ground, as vehicles are not permitted closer to the birds. Tour is not recommended for those with neck, back problems or mobility challenges. Tour is subject to sea conditions, participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Tour does not stop in Stanley. There are only basic restroom facilities and a shelter. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

RIDE TO THE ROCKHOPPER PENGUINS

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_29

Observe around 300 Rockhopper penguins in their natural environment with stunning views of Berkeley Sound in the background. This is your opportunity to photograph these penguins so named due to their fondness of jumping over rocks.

A 30 minute drive on an unsurfaced road takes you to the Murrell Farm. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by friendly

local driver/guides who will transfer you into 4x4 vehicles. Your exciting one hour off-road experience, will take you over the rolling peaty moor to the colony.

At the colony, you'll have approximately one hour to wander at leisure. Guides are permanently based and will answer any of your questions. Enjoy cakes and cookies served with coffee or tea at the onsite cabin and browse the locally crafted souvenirs.

Note: Tour not recommended for those with neck, back problems or mobility challenges. Tour participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required for tour to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers. Tour is not offered on Norwegian Sun's February 13th and February 27th, 2016 sailings.

NORTH POND PENGUIN QUEST

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_32

Embark on a fantastic 4x4 adventure out to the north coast of East Falkland. Your journey starts at the pier, where you'll meet your local driver/guide in a 4x4. Drive for 1 1/2 hours along an unsurfaced road en route to Cape Dolphin and take in the rugged beauty of the islands.

Rock formations locally known as "Stone Runs" will be seen, as will remnants of an Argentine Chinook and an Argentine Puma from the 1982 conflict. Before reaching Cape Dolphin you'll leave the unsurfaced road for a 30 minute off-road experience.

At North Pond you'll have the opportunity to get up close and personal with an abundance of Gentoo and Magellanic penguins. King Penguins which regularly visit, might be seen wandering the very beautiful sandy beach which stretches for approximately half a mile.

The pure white sand, crystal blue water and wandering penguins provide you with stunning photo opportunities. There's an abundance of birdlife here so you may spot Upland Geese, Grebes, Turkey Vultures, Flightless Steamer Duck and other species. Peale's Dolphins are occasionally seen frolicking in the surf. A packed lunch is provided.

Note: Tour not recommended for those with neck, back problems or mobility challenges. The Falklands is renowned for its four seasons in one day so please be prepared for any weather. A packed lunch will be provided. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

GENTOO PENGUINS AT NEWANS FARM

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_34

Travel in small groups on this 4x4 off road adventure and spend some time with breeding pairs of Gentoo penguins. Join your mini-bus and driver guide at the Jetty Visitor Centre for a 15 minute ride to nearby Newans Farm. Here you'll meet your 4x4 drivers, who will take you to the nearby Gentoo penguins. Experience an off road adventure and admire the scenery while learning more about the Falklands way of life.

There are approximately 200 breeding pairs of Gentoo penguins at this scenic site. Enjoy approximately 45 minutes with the penguins, before your returning off road journey.

Note: Tour not recommended for those with neck, back problems or mobility challenges. Tour participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required for tour to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

FALKLAND BATTLEFIELDS

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_26

Travel back in time to the main battles fought during the 1982 Falklands conflict and en route, enjoy beautiful panoramas. Your expert guide will explain the events that led up to the fierce battle between Argentina and Britain.

Departing Stanley you'll travel west while your guide provides an overview of the history of the islands. Enjoy beautiful panoramas taking in Boot Hill and the wind turbines that supply the capital with up to 40% of its energy requirements. Your guide will explain the events that led up to the 1982 conflict ending with the arrival of British Forces at San Carlos on landing day.

Estancia Farm was a base for hundreds of British troops starting in June 1982. A large group of local men and women went to help look after the troops, even using their off road driving skills to move munitions under the cover of darkness up the mountain sides. Your coach will stop here and you can leave the bus to enjoy the views while your guide explains about the "yomp" from San Carlos and the battle for Goose Green.

You'll make a couple of more stops, one at the site of the wreckage of the Chinook and Puma and another at a location where you can enjoy the view of Stanley and the surrounding five battle site mountains, while your guide provides details about the final battles.

Note: Tour involves some walking over uneven terrain and there are no restroom facilities. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

FALKLAND NATURE TREK

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_24

For the nature enthusiast, this is an exclusive opportunity to view Falkland Islands wildlife and flora, including native Falkland birds, approximately 20-30 different species. Drive to picturesque Whalebone Cove, where your walk starts. Your expert guide will distribute a tour specific illustrated checklist and give a general background to Falkland wildlife and what you might expect to see on this tour.

Walk around the coastline to Hadassa Bay, where you might find dark-faced ground-tyrants, Falkland thrush, upland geese and the beautiful long-tailed meadowlark, just to name a few. There are also great views of Stanley and your ship at anchor. You may see shorebirds such as the Falkland flightless steamer duck and rock cormorants and looking out to sea southern giant petrels and sooty shearwaters.

There's a chance of seeing Peale's dolphins following tenders back and forth. In this beautiful bay, Magellanic penguins burrow in the grass and the black-throated finch can be spotted. Lots of local flora will be spotted, such as Diddle-Dee, Gorse, Pale Maiden, Falkland Lavender, Wooly Falkland Ragwort and Vanilla Daisy.

Note: Tour requires 3.5 miles of brisk walking over uneven terrain. Tour participation is limited and a minimum number of participants is required for tour to operate – book early to avoid disappointment. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers. We recommend that you bring binoculars and a pen or pencil to track your sightings.

STANLEY WALKING TOUR

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_27

On arrival into Stanley Harbour the first thing you'll notice is the fantastic colors of this capital and what better way to get acquainted than with a guided walk through its picturesque streets.

Your walk takes in key sites around Stanley such as Christ Church Cathedral, Whale Bone Arch, the mizzen mast of the SS Great Britain on Victory Green, the 1982 Battle Memorial, Government House with its beautiful gardens, and the 1914 memorial.

Your guide will give you insight into the local way of life whilst showing you the beautiful capital. The tour ends with a visit to the Historic Dockyard Museum, which depicts the local history. The walk takes a leisurely pace and includes a number of opportunities for photographs, giving you plenty of time to make the most of your visit.

Note: Tour involves walking a distance of approximately 1 1/2 miles. Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

STANLEY HIGHLIGHTS

Stanley, Falkland Islands Tour Code: PSY_21

Enjoy an introduction to the Falklands small capital. As your coach drives along Stanley's main street which runs along the sea front, your expert guide will point out everything that may be of interest. Some of the highlights you'll see include the cathedral with its whale bone arch, the 1982 Battle Memorial, the Government House, wrecks of the old sailing ships, minefields, and some of the original houses.

You'll get a good idea of the islanders' daily life in this rugged, remote but beautiful location. Your guide's commentary will provide you with additional insight about the Falklands. Drive out of town to see a stunning view of Stanley from the bottom of the harbor and the shipwreck the Lady Elizabeth. The tour ends at the Jetty Visitor Centre where you'll have the option to visit the nearby Historic Dockyard Museum to learn more about the history of the Falklands, admission is included.

Note: Weather in the Falklands is unpredictable and temperatures fluctuate, dress in layers.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
