Accessible Alesund - AE36

Enjoy a guided tour of “The Venice of Norway” via wheelchair-accessible coach. Ålesund, a colorful city of seven islands dotted with canals and narrow streets, features distinctive Art Nouveau architecture, chosen for the city’s rebuilding after a disastrous 1904 fire. At the Sunnmore Open Air Museum, see how Norwegians lived from the Middle Ages through the 19th century. Plus enjoy magnificent views of the city, harbor and mountains from Mount Aksla.

Highlights:

- Wheelchair-accessible coach tour: Spend three hours learning the history and admiring the colorful Art Nouveau architecture of Ålesund.
- Sunnmore Open Air Museum: Explore 55 old-style Norwegian homes and see detailed replicas of Viking ships.

Atlantic Ocean Park & Aksla Viewpoint - AE34

The tour takes you up to the Mount Aksla view point for a spectacular view of the city, islands and the Sunnmore Mountains. To give you an insight into the multitude of life beneath the waves, you will visit the Atlantic Sea Park, one of the largest aquariums in Northern Europe and the largest in Scandinavia

Tour Alesund's famous Art Nouveau district and take a drive up Mount Aksla for a spectacular view of the city, the islands and the Sunnmore Mountains. Then, you will head out of town to the Atlantic Sea Park situated along the oceanfront at Tueneset. The park occupies 1.4 acres of coastal scenery with fishing spots, hiking trails, swimming sites and outstanding diving venues. Atlantic Sea Park contains exhibition space and is the largest aquarium in Scandinavia. It is uniquely built into coastal surroundings and adapted to modern exhibition principles. Large landscape aquariums teem with ocean life direct from the ocean, with an emphasis on the western regions. You can see what the marine life is like under the ferry quay, in the ocean current, between islets and skerries, and in the depths of the Storfjorden. Watch the huge fish and enjoy watching the diver feeding the fish by hand in the large Atlantic Ocean tank. Note: Guests must be able to walk approximately 0.50 mile over varying terrain with steps and inclines at the Sea Park. Comfortable walking shoes and a light jacket are recommended. Tour order may vary but all mentioned sites will be covered.

On Foot in the Art Nouveau Town - AE19

Set off on foot for an up-close and personal look at Alesund. In 1904, a catastrophic fire left the city in ashes and over 10,000 people homeless. Rebuilt and reborn in Art Nouveau style, using materials from all over Europe, today the city is a shining example of Norwegian resiliency. See the colorful architecture of the city center, and then explore the historic harbor for a look at Alesund's deep ties to the sea.

This guided tour is your opportunity to experience one of the last remaining Art Nouveau cities. Perched on seven coastal islands connected by canals and bordered by fjords and mountains, this centuries-old seaport is awash in bright colors and rich in decorative architecture. Stroll through Old Town and the picturesque fishing harbor, steeped in maritime tradition, as your guide shares local history and lore, including Alesund's valiant recovery and rebuilding after a devastating 1904 fire.

Outer Islands - AE33

The tour takes you to the Saga Islands of Giske and Godøy, connected to Alesund and the mainland by bridges and one of the longest sub-sea tunnel connections in the world. Visit the Roman marble church, Giske Chapel, dating back to 1135. It was once the influent Giske family chapel. To give you an insight into the multitude of life beneath the waves, you will visit the Atlantic Sea Park, one of the largest aquariums in Northern Europe and the largest in Scandinavia. On the return back to the ship you will visit the Mount Aksla view point.

Leaving the city, you drive through some of the sub-sea tunnels connecting the islands with the mainland.

The island of Giske is known as the birthplace of the famous Viking "Gange-Rolv" or Rollo, who became Duke of Normandy in 911. With its powerful families, Viking Kings and heirs the island was a seat of power in the Viking Age. You stop to visit the Giske Chapel - a Romanesque marble church dating from the 12th century. It was built as a private chapel for the Giske family. Its interior was restored in 1756 and has a beautifully carved and painted alter-piece and pulpit. Continue to the island of Godøy with a visit to the charming and unique little fishing village of Alnes, located on the shores of the Atlantic. You stop here for a short break at the Alnes Lighthouse to enjoy the magnificent view. Before returning to Alesund, you'll make a detour to Mount Aksla, overlooking the town and the surrounding islands.

The Path of the Trolls - AE20

Trollstigen, also known as The Path of the Trolls, is a roadway that was literally blasted out of the mountainside. What's even more impressive is where it takes you. Following 11 hairpin turns, you'll cross the Stigfoss Waterfall that drops 585 feet beneath you. Look up to see sheer peaks thrusting 600 feet skyward. This is a journey into Norway's most dramatic landscape with mountains, valleys, rivers, gorges, and waterfalls at every turn.

Relax in your motor coach on a mountain journey of spellbinding natural beauty, weaving through the 11 hairpin turns of the Path of the Trolls to Troll Wall, Europe's highest vertical mountain wall. You'll pass picturesque villages on the way to 12th-century Stordal Church and Gudbrandsjuvet gorge, surrounded by needle-sharp mountain peaks and gushing waterfalls. Sample genuine Norwegian cuisine and chat with friends on a stop for lunch at a local restaurant.

Highlights:

- Path of the Trolls: Lush greenery and rugged slopes frame the 11 hairpin turns to the 1,500-foot-high Troll Wall.
- Stordal Church: Marvel at the frescoes and rose paintings then enjoy traditional Norwegian cuisine at a local restaurant.
- Gudbrandsjuvet: Stand 2,500 feet above sea level to see the river running through the gorge.
