Petra, The Rose Red Desert City - AQ01

Petra is a fortress city created by the Nabataeans more than 2000 years ago. Upon arrival at Petra, you will walk to the entrance of the "Siq", a very narrow, descending ancient river bed winding its way through the gorge for approximately 3 kilometers. Towering walls of rock reach 300 feet high and at the final turn, out of the gloom appears the brilliance of Petra's Treasury, 140 feet high, 90 feet wide and carved out of solid rock. Continue beyond the Treasury and marvel at the towering temples, royal tombs, carved Roman theatre, burial chambers, paved streets, large and small houses and public buildings. A buffet lunch is included.

Discover the wonders of one of the world's most famous archaeological sites, the ancient fortress city of Petra, half-built/half-carved from rock and towering cliffs. Founded by Nabateans more than 2,000 years ago at the crossroads of Arabia, Egypt and Syria-Phoenicia, Petra derived its wealth from the caravan trade. Its spectacular construction - reflecting eastern, Hellenistic and later Roman influences - is considered an unparalleled masterpiece of sculpted art. Petra's remote mountain location kept it hidden for centuries.

Highlights:

- Siq: Walk through this tall winding gorge that forms the dramatic entrance to the ancient trading city founded by Nabateans.
- Architectural Marvels: The spectacular Treasury, towering temples, tombs, a Roman theater, homes and more are carved/built from the rose-hued rock.
- Lunch and Shopping: Recharge over a buffet lunch at a nearby hotel and some free time to browse for souvenirs.

Wadi Rum - AQ03

Explore the spectacular mix of expanses of red sand, imposing mountains and dramatic formations of granite, balsalt and sandstone sculpted by wind in Jordan's valley of Wadi Rum. Archaeological evidence dates back some 7,000 years but for centuries it has been home to Bedouins who live in tents and tend their herds. Journey by open-air jeeps across the vast desert landscape, marveling at the stark beauty and silence when the engines are switched off.

Highlights:

- 4x4 Drive: Travel across red sands past massive mountains, rock bridges and other dramatic geological formations of the desert valley.
- Cinematic Landscape: "Lawrence of Arabia" is among the films shot in the area, also called the Valley of the Moon.
- Bedouin Hospitality: Rest and relax in a tent where tea and traditional sweets will be served.
