Agios Gerasimos, Robola Winery and Drogkarati Cave - 0005

Experience Kefalonia's history, culture and nature on a threepart excursion that includes time at a monastery founded by the island's patron saint to care for the poor, a local winery, and a cave known for unique formations.

Get close to Kefalonia's rich history, culture and nature on a diverse, three-part adventure. Start with a visit to Agios Gerasimos, the monastery founded by the island's patron saint, a monk who is revered by Kefalonians as a protector and a healer. Then make your way to Robola Winery for a taste of the delicious local wine, including a white varietal with lemony tones. Next, tour the Drogkarati Cave, with its astonishing stalagmites and stalactites.

Highlights:

- Agios Gersimos: This 16th century monastery was founded by a former hermit monk Gerasimos, patron saint of the island.
- Robola Winery: Visit the largest winery on the island, established in 1982. Enjoy tastes of white, red and rosé.
- Drogkarati Cave: Admire the amazing stalactites that seem to hang in mid drip from the roof.

Melissani Cave and Mythos Cooking Demonstration - 0014

Leaving the harbour of Argostoli, we head to subterranean Melissani Cave -Lake where part if its limestone ceiling has collapsed creating a haunting place with deep blue water. Your tour will continue to Mythos estiasis where you will enjoy a cooking class and a wine tasting.

Discover the unique beauty of a geological phenomenon at the Melissani Cave and learn how to create authentic Greek cooking during a visit to Kefallonia Island. You'll explore the subterranean cave and float through a tunnel to its underground crystal blue-green colored lake. Next, visit the Mythos estiasis for your traditional Kefallonian cooking lesson and savor samples of locally produced wines and a variety of cheeses at a tasting hosted by an oenologist.

Highlights:

- Kefallonia Island: Visit one of the most popular destinations of the Ionian island and the biggest island group
- Melissani Cave: Explore a lacustrine cave full of unique natural works of art created by stalactites
- Melissani Lake: Float along this underground lake that was once a place of worship dedicated to Pan and Nymph Melissanthi -
- Mythos Cooking Lesson: The chef will demostrate how to cook a typical Kefallonian dish.
- Wine tasting: Delight in exquisite local wines at a tasting hosted by an oenologist
