UNESCO Gyeongju Historic Area and Busan City - KP07

Enjoy a scenic drive to Gyeongju, The capital of the Silla Dynasty, designated by UNESCO as one of the world ten most historically significant sights. Your trip begins at Bulguksa Temple, originally constructed in 535 A.D. Continue on to Tumuli Park to view a collection of about 20 Royal Silla tombs. Visit the Flying Horse tomb. Drive to Yongdusan, Busan for a photo stop and then visit the popular Jagalchi Fish Market, a must-see in Busan. A Korean buffet lunch is included on this tour.

Discover South Korea's Bulguksa Temple, Tumuli Park and Jagalchi Fish Market on a 7-hours tour. Enjoy a scenic drive to Gyeongju, the capital of the Silla Dynasty, and explore the 6th century Bulguksa Temple built during the reign of King Beop-Heung.
