Boone Hall Plantation - CE15

Journey across the Cooper River to the town of Mt. Pleasant. Here you will visit historic Boone Hall Plantation that was used in the filming of the television mini-series, "North and South" and "Queen" and for background filming in "Gone with the Wind." Tour the lovely Colonial Revival plantation house, the slave quarters built from brick made on the plantation in the 1800's and watch the flower ladies making their sweetgrass baskets.

Explore Charleston's illustrious history and culture on a guided tour of the antebellum Boone Hall Plantation, complete with beautiful gardens and live historical reenactments. Travel via motor coach across the expansive Cooper River and past low-country marshes en route to seaside Mount Pleasant. Roam around grand Boone Hall Plantation, a Colonial Revival house where you can view antique furnishings, watch the flower ladies weave sweet grass baskets, see original slave quarters, and visit the butterfly pavilion.

Highlights:

- Scenic Drive: Relish spectacular views of low-country marshes and the mighty Cooper River while traveling via coach to Mount Pleasant.
- Boone Hall Plantation: Tour the Colonial Revival mansion with a 19th-century guide, admiring antique housewares and 100-year-old rose gardens.

Haunted Charleston - CE44

On this comprehensive two hour tour you will have the exclusive opportunity to visit some of Charleston's most haunted destinations after dark.

Chilling tales of ghosts, haunted houses, voodoo, and Lowcountry superstitions — hear all of these and more on an eerie, after-dark amble through Charleston's haunted Historic District. Your two-hour guided walk includes an exclusive, behind-the-scenes tour of the Provost Dungeon, Charleston's only pre-revolutionary dungeon. Located in the Old Exchange building, see where pirates languished and patriots were imprisoned by the British for treason or sedition. Then step inside the gates of the city's oldest graveyard, where witnesses have seen orbs, strange mists and apparitions. The Circular Congregational Church's graveyard includes more than 150 graves from before the Revolutionary War; see if you can find the grave dating back to the 1690s. After, head to Bocci's, a popular Italian restaurant, for a glass of wine. Be sure to pay a visit to the third floor, where, reportedly, doors open and close on their own, and voices and mysterious rapping on doors are heard.

Highlights:

- Provost Dungeon at the Old Exchange Building: Souls of imprisoned pirates and patriots are said to still stir.
- Circular Congregational Church Graveyard: Some report orbs and strange mists; some hear voices around the ancient oak trees.
- Bocci's Italian Restaurant: Sip a glass of wine while hearing of ghostly activities that have transpired on the third floor.
