## Accessible Alicante - AL10

Tour must be booked in advance of the cruise in order to secure equipment and departure time. Tour begins with short drive thru city center passing Paseo del Puerto, Luceros Square & Train Station. In Elche, visit Municipal Park. Most interesting visit is at "Huerto del Cura."

Enjoy a short but scenic drive around Alicante before meandering wheelchair-accessible pathways through a teeming botanical park. Snap photos of Luceros Square's sculptured fountain and train station en route to Municipal Park, where you'll encounter abundant native Spanish plants and palm trees. Discover exotic flora and spouting fountains at main attraction Huerto del Cura gardens. Partake in a tasting of liquor and dried fruits, or wind your way around the grounds independently.

**Highlights:**

- Luceros Square: Catch a glimpse of the train station and gallantly chiseled fountain while driving through scenic Alicante.
- Municipal Park: Behold Spanish plants and thousands of towering palm trees, as you roam the outdoor space.
- Huerto del Cura: Explore lush botanical gardens along the main lake and wheelchair-accessible trails.

## Alicante City Sightseeing - AL11

Tour begins at Castle of Santa Barbara. Inside the Castle, admire Iberian archeological findings. Continue visit to the Main Tower (Torre del Homenaje) and the Englishmen's bastions. After visit to Castle, buses will drive you to the Explanada de Espana. From there, take a short walk to the historical center of the city closed to cars & arrive at the Town Hall Square. Visit the "Museo de Fogueres". View sculptures made of plaster and paper mache from different time periods. You will free time to explore on your own before heading back to ship. Note: must walk approx. 0.5 mile over varying surfaces & steps. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.

Explore Alicante's illustrious history and delve into the city's vibrant culture as you see notable landmarks and roam museum exhibits before wandering the streets independently. Visit the 9th-century Caste of Santa Barbara overlooking the city, walk along Explanada de España's colorful mosaic pathway, and stroll the pedestrian-only Town Hall Square. Admire plaster sculptures and typical costumes associated with the Bonfires of San Juan event at Museo de Fogueres. Shop, dine and mosey at your leisure.

- City Landmarks: Visit the Castle of Santa Barbara, stroll the colorful Explanada de España, and roam around Town Hall Square.
- Museo de Fogueres: View an impressive collection of sculptures and costumes featured in the annual Bonfires of San Juan festival.

## Alicante Segway - AL17

Explore Alicante on a guided tour that's informative, scenic, and a whole lot of fun. You'll Segway down the Explanada, a beautiful mosaic promenade paved with 6.5 million marble tiles. Climb the terraced slopes and stone paths of Ereta Park. Then climb up a 544 foot mountain to 10th-century Santa Barbara Castle, complete with cannons, a palace, dungeons, a moat and a cliff-side lookout tower with views of city, harbor and sea.

**Overview:** Explore Alicante on a guided tour that's informative, scenic, and a whole lot of fun. You'll Segway down the Explanada, a beautiful mosaic promenade paved with 6.5 million marble tiles. Climb the terraced slopes and stone paths of Ereta Park. Then climb up a 544 foot mountain to 10th-century Santa Barbara Castle, complete with cannons, a palace, dungeons, a moat and a cliff-side lookout tower with views of city, harbor and sea.

## Guadalest - AL09

You will leave from the port of Alicante towards Guadalest, passing through some villages on the internal side of the region such as La Nuria, Polop de La Marina, and Callosa de Ensarria. During your walking tour, you will visit the San Jose Castle. This castle is located at top of city and has its origin from 6th century. In walled enclosure, they emphasize Parochial Church, Orduna House & prison. Afterwards, you will have free time for drink or shopping before return to ship. Note: Tour involves quite a lot walking in Guadalest. Approx 1 - 2 miles of walking over varying surfaces.

Journey through Alicante's rural hillsides and explore the charming village of Guadalest, where you will join a guided walking tour before roaming at your leisure. Travel on foot through quaint cobblestone streets in Guadalest, a mountaintop town and former military stronghold. Behold hilltop San Jose Castle, an 11th-century Gothic fortress, before visiting the Orduña House's church, museum, prison and library. Enjoy free time to wander independently, savor a tasty Spanish meal or shop for souvenirs.
