OVERVIEW: Discover the village of Agioi Apostoloi and enjoy the shallow waters at one of the three sandy beaches.

HIGHLIGHTS: You will have approximately 3 hours of free time. Each beach has a small canteen where you can purchase refreshments or a light snack. **NOTES:** This is not a shuttle service. Akrotiri & Chania Town - IQ05

Depart the Port of Souda to the British Commonwealth War Cemetery. A photo stop will be made. Tour continues to Ag. Triada Monastery (Holy Trinity) of Jagarolon. Explore independently the town before returning to the port. Note: Guests must walk approximately 1 mile over various surfaces and cobblestone streets with 20+ steps at the monastery and 5 to 10 at the museum. Conservative attire with no exposed shoulders or knees is recommended for monastery visit. Short pants, tank tops and revealing clothing are not acceptable. If guests miss the return bus, transportation back to the vessel is at their own responsibility/expense. The drive to/from Souda Port is approx 30 minutes each way.

Board a motorcoach for a photo stop at British Commonwealth War Cemetery, then visit a monastic complex at Jagarolon, see the Venizelos Tombs at the hill of Prophet Elijah, and stroll among neoclassical mansions and massive Venetian fortifications in Chania. See the gravesite of soldiers who participated in the Battle of Crete during WWII. Continue to a significant monastery, see Venizelos Tombs of Modern Greek politicians, and conclude with free time to explore Chania.

- British Commonwealth Cemetery: Take pictures at this beautifully situated memorial honoring soldiers who fought to keep Crete free.
- Agia Triada Monastery: See the 15th century complex set majestically atop a rocky pinnacle, overlooking surrounding mountains and valleys.
