Time at museums may not permit viewing of all exhibitions.

Ride through the city past Christchurch Cathedral and the Botanical Gardens on your way to the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory. There, tour exhibits of Aboriginal art and works from the Oceania region. Then head to Crocodylus Park, where things get more primal — don't miss watching deadly saltwater crocodiles display their strength during an exciting feeding demonstration.

Darwin Walking Tour - DN15

Set off on a walking tour through the history, heritage, and culture of Darwin. A local guide will share stories you won't find in any travel book. Visit the WWII Memorial and learn about Aussie aviation pioneers. See monuments to early European explorers. Gain rare insight into Aboriginal culture. Visit Bicentennial Park and see the old Overland Telegraph Line. Enjoy amazing views of the harbor and beaches as you explore Darwin on foot. The order of sights visited may vary and itinerary may be reversed. The weather can be quite hot and humid. Guests walk for 2 hours for 3 miles. Guests with mobility issues should not select tour. Litchfield National Park is a favorite among nature lovers who come to hike the trails, explore the bush land, and swim beneath cascading waterfalls. Follow the bush tracks to the Buley Rock Pools (or similar) for a dip in the cool water. Kick back and enjoy the view or jump right in and feel the water rush over you. Plan to get more than your feet wet on this wilderness adventure. Guests must be able to walk approximately 500 yards over even and uneven rocky natural ground with 80 steps at Florence Falls. Only 1 swimming stop is guaranteed. A look out area is provided for those that do not wish to swim.

Immerse yourself in the beauty of Litchfield Park. Explore spectacular waterfalls, cool off in one of the swimming holes and take in the scenic surroundings. Explore the walking paths and discover monsoon rainforests, fascinating rock formations, caves, natural forests and thunderous cascades. Plunge into the clear Buley Rockhole swimming pools (or similar) for a refreshing and cool dip. Then delve into a delicious casual BBQ lunch.
