Gijon City Tour - GJ01

Enjoy a panoramic drive through the city of Gijon. Proceed to the Universidad Laboral. (External views only due to construction.) Tour continues as you learn how to make Cider, a typical Asturia's drink. You will get to see how it is made and tastes along with a selection of wonderful cheese. A panoramic drive along the sea-front will take you down town, for a walking tour of the city, and view of the impressive sculpture that has become the symbol of the city, the Praise to the Horizon. There will be time for shopping. Note: must walk approx. 500 yards (approx 2.5 hours) over various uneven surfaces with a few steps. Tour order may vary between groups but covering all mentioned sites.

Delve into Gijón's dynamic culture via motor coach and on foot, as you visit its renowned university, taste a signature cider beverage, and roam independently. Travel through town on a comfortable bus past the Universidad Laboral, the largest in Spain. Learn how to make cider, a customary Asturias drink produced from locally grown apples. Join a guided downtown walking tour, where you will see Chillida's "Praise to the Horizon" sculpture and enjoy free shopping time.

- Scenic Drive: Hop on a motor coach for a ride through Gijón, passing the sprawling Universidad Laboral, Spain's largest university.
