Willemstad: City, Ostrich Farm & Cave Adventure

ACTIVITY LEVEL: MODERATE

You will board your **Hyundai Coaster** on a sightseeing drive through Willemstad on your way to the **Ostrich Farm** where you can observe the fascinating behavior of this very special bird. You will see first-hand how an ostrich develops from an egg to the biggest and fastest running bird in the world. You will have a chance to hold an enormous egg or a little fluffy day-old chick: and even get to see one hatch. Also you can feed the birds as they poke their heads into the jeep or jump on the safari truck for a funny interactive guided tour! Then you will be off for the famous **Hato Caves**. These old coral reefs that actually emerged out of the sea when the island was formed are "living caves"; and centuries-old stalagmites and stalactites are still being formed, a drop at a time. The guided tour will take you along gently sloping trails through the caves' different chambers, past still pools, even a fresh-water waterfall (a very rare sight on this dry island). These caves were once the homes of the Indians.

Willemstad: Curacao Jeep Safari

ACTIVITY LEVEL: MODERATE

With a fleet of **off-road 4x4 Land Cruisers**, your drivers will offer a guided adventurous way to explore Curacao and discover new places you have never been before. You will be picked up at the dock and guided to the Land Cruisers. There you will get a briefing on safety in reference to driving in open vehicles, specifically in the "**wild Curacao" terrain**. After you have been seated in the vehicles you will be driven towards the wild terrain, where your 4x4 outdoor adventure will start. Driving through Curacao's wild nature terrain, with cacti, divi-divi trees, and possible spotting of wara wara birds of pray, lizards, flamingos and wild pigs will certainly be one of the highlights of your tour. During a visit to the famous "Driftwood Bay" you will get information about the bays on Curacao and you have a chance to search for driftwood pieces, often used as souvenirs.

<u>Please note</u>: This tour is not for those with back or neck problems.

Willemstad: The Heart of Curacao

The best of everything. This comfortable tour will bring you to the heart of "**Otro Banda**" at the **Kura Hulanda Village** where you will walk around. Reboard your vehicle and while you are driving through the Jewish Quarter in Punda you will end up on top of the hill where **Fort Nassau** will offer stunning photo opportunities. You then will drive to **Baai Klaa**s to look out over the **Jan Kok Sales Planes** and visit the land house of former slave owner "Jan Kok," now the home of an art gallery of the famous Nena Sanchez. A visit to the flamingo sanctuary will close this entertaining tour.

Willemstad: UNESCO World City Heritage Walk

ACTIVITY LEVEL: MODERATE

The unique architecture and special maritime history plus the fact that Curacao is on the famous**UNESCO World Heritage** list will make this walk a fascinating one! After a short briefing by your guide you will walk to the **Rif Fort** where the guide will explain the history of the area. On your way to the city center of **Punda**, with its world famous colored houses, you will cross the **St. Anna Bay** by public ferry. At the 'handelskade' you will find Punda's shopping area and you will learn about the history of this area. Another of Curacao's "must see" areas is the famous "floating market" where merchants from Venezuela sell their fruit and vegetables A refreshing welcome drink will be waiting for you at the **Maritime Museum** where you can see the nautical history of Curaçao. At the end of the tour you can walk back to the ship through Punda on your own, with opportunities for shopping and/or more sight-seeing or walk back with your guide.

<u>Please note</u>: This tour is on flat level ground and will include about 1.5 miles of walking. Wear comfortable walking shoes and sun protection and bring your camera. The walk is wheelchair accessible as long as wheelchair guest is accompanied.
