Marigot: America's Cup Sailboat Racing

ACTIVITY LEVEL: MODERATE

Experience the thrill of racing multi-million dollar America's Cup Race sailboats in the warm blue waters and brisk trade winds of St. Maarten. Previous sailing experience is not necessary for this excursion, which is one of the highest rated in the Caribbean. You will depart directly from your yacht in Marigot to Philipsburg, where after a briefing you will take a 10-minute tender ride out to your allocated sailboat. Either Dennis Conner's America's Cup winning *Stars & Stripes, Canada II*, or *True North* are yours for this **once-in-a-lifetime adventure**. The expert crew will show you exactly what to do if you want to take a "crew member's" position. Then it's off to the racecourse – grind a winch – trim a sail – punch a stopwatch, or just sit back, relax and enjoy the included refreshments. After the race enjoy a victory rum punch party and browse through the museum souvenir boutique for a lasting memento of your America's Cup adventure.

Please note: Wear suitable footwear for the sailboat. This event is weather/wind dependent.

Marigot: Discover St. Martin - Independent Explorer

ACTIVITY LEVEL: EASY

The Independent Explorer gives you the opportunity to **discover St. Martin and St. Maarten on your own**. You will be provided with an island map, a suggested itinerary, and some general advice. You will have enough time to discover and enjoy some of the **36 beaches** as well as shopping and browsing in both capitals.

Please note: Expect bumpy, hilly driving conditions. Bring your camera, swimwear, driver's license and credit card. The tour price includes CDW insurance with a 1500 Euro deductible which will be fully or partially charged to the driver's credit card in the event the vehicle is returned damaged. Guests must be at least 25 to rent a car. No cars will be available from December 23, 2015 to January 1, 2016.

Marigot: Mix & Match Perfume Class

ACTIVITY LEVEL: EASY

Create your own essence! Board your motor coach at the pier for the 25-minute ride to **Grand Case Village**. You will take a 90-minute class, learning how perfumes are made and creating your own perfume or cologne. You will have a selection of 300 oils to choose from, creating three different scents. You will then choose your favorite among the three, name it, label it and bottle it. In addition to your own perfume, you will receive a gift bag of Tijon products valued at about \$100. The highly trained Tijon staff will provide as much individual assistance as needed. Since the most difficult part of the class is coming up with a name you might want to start thinking about it when you sign up for the class.

Marigot: Under Two Flags Island Tour

ACTIVITY LEVEL: EASY

The island of St. Martin is the smallest island to be shared by two sovereign countries. The border is symbolic, as goods and people can move from one side to the other quite freely. You will board your bus for the 30-minute ride to the top of **Cay Hill** where you can admire the turquoise waters of the Caribbean and the islands of Saba, St. Eustatius, St. Kitts and Nevis. After leaving Cay Hill, you will pass along the Great Salt Pond before time to shop in Philipsburg, capital of the Dutch side of the island. Philipsburg is well known for **Front Street** and its busy **Boardwalk** where rates can be very attractive, especially for designer clothes, electronics, jewelry, linens, and perfumes. You will continue to the French side and stop at the panoramic lookout point at Oyster Pond, with spectacular views of the Atlantic Coast and the islands of Tintamarre and St. Barth. Pass the famous Orient Bay Beach, the largest white-sand beach on the island. You will be dropped off in Marigot to enjoy the French capital at your leisure.
