## Tour Descriptions for Burnie (Tasmania), Australia

### ANNSLEIGH GARDENS & WILDLIFE

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_04**

Tasmania is famous for the Tasmanian Devil as well as its impressive gardens. Visit the award winning Annsleigh Gardens and Wing's Farm Park, a massive reserve with an impressive array of native Australian animals.

Your relaxing drive takes you through the picturesque countryside of Tasmania, passing fields and lush green vistas en route to Wing's Farm Park. Here, you'll find Tasmanian Devils, Quoll's, and other native wildlife as well as farm creatures including reptiles and kangaroos. What about visiting the animal nursery?

Visit the award-winning Annsleigh Gardens, an English style Garden covering two hectares. These carefully landscaped and tended Gardens feature rockeries, paved courtyards, fountains, waterways and sunken gardens. Enjoy some free time exploring this lovely attraction.

### BURNIE HIGHLIGHTS & CHEESE TASTING

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_02**

Visit some of Burnie's most notable highlights such as the Pioneer Village Museum and the Maker's Workshop. Enjoy a cheese tasting and learn how Roo Poo Paper is made.

Enjoy a scenic drive around Burnie stopping at the Wilfred Campbell lookout for an excellent photo opportunity. Visit the Burnie Pioneer Museum to see the recreation of the main street of Burnie as it was in the 1900's at the height of the town's first economic boom. Admire the authentic 19th century materials, colors and architectural styles that have been used in the reconstruction.

A stop at the Maker's Workshop gives you a look at some of the area's history, innovators and artists. Stimulate the taste buds at the Cheese Tasting Center where you may wish to buy one or more of the large range available that are made at the factory. Tasmania is famous for many things, but among the lesser known is its paper production. Visit Australia's largest handmade paper studio, Creative Paper. See full size paper sculptures and a range of wonderful paper products including the most unusual 'Roo Poo Paper' incorporating a special kangaroo by-product.

## DEVILS & ROOS

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_06**

Combine the beautiful Tasmanian countryside and Australian native animals at the Wing's Farm Park with an orientation drive through the city.

Take a scenic drive through the northern region of Tasmania, incorporating some of this island state's most picturesque countryside. Gunns Plains is a prosperous farming district located approximately 45 minutes south of Burnie and where you'll find Wing's Farm Park. Here, you can explore at your own pace and see Tasmanian Devils, Quoll's, and other native wildlife including reptiles and kangaroos. Alternatively, take the opportunity to visit the animal nursery. Before returning to the ship, take a brief drive through Burnie and learn about this Tasmanian gateway to the north.

## GUNNS PLAINS CAVES & WILDLIFE

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_03**

Enjoy a day in the picturesque countryside discovering the caves of Gunns Plains and Australian native animals at Wings Wildlife Park. Your drive takes you through Tasmania's picturesque countryside and lush green vistas en route to Gunns Plains—a prosperous farming district located south of Burnie. Limestone caves are the region's main attraction, discovered by a hunter in 1906. Caverns and short passages are accessed by a flight of concrete stairs, and you'll wind your way through the caves on a guided tour. See an underground river and bioluminescent glow worms, as well as the unusual "ribbon" stalactites.

Drive to the Wing's Wildlife Park, set on 106 acres. Tasmanian devils, quolls, and many other native animals and farm creatures live here, including reptiles and kangaroos. During your approximately one hour of free time, visit the animal nursery if you wish, or simply explore the park and meet its inhabitants.

Note: There is a steep descent of 54 concrete steps to access the caves. Walking and level of exertion at Wings Wildlife Park is at guest's discretion. Temperature in the caves can be cool, we suggest you bring a sweater or light jacket.

## MAJESTIC CRADLE MOUNTAIN

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_01**

Discover one of the most popular natural areas in Tasmania, Cradle Mountain in Lake St Clair National Park. Your scenic drive takes approximately 90 minutes, stretching from Cradle Mountain to Southwest Cape including rainforests, sub-alpine lakes and Tasmania's highest peak. It is a wild landscape with the jagged peaks of the mountains as a backdrop.

Stop at the Cradle Mountain Interpretation Center, with displays of the area's flora and fauna as well as history. You'll have the opportunity to admire and walk through the rainforest and view Pencil Pine Creek and waterfalls from an elevated boardwalk. Board a minivan for the drive to Dove Lake, for views of the Lake and Cradle Mountain; it is one of the highlights of your day. Weather permitting, you may be able to view dramatic Cradle Mountain reflected in the still waters of Dove Lake. You'll enjoy approximately one hour of free time here to take in the activity of your choice. Take a walk around the lake, explore the surroundings or simply sit back and enjoy the spectacular views.

During your visit, enjoy a light lunch at the Cradle Mountain Hotel's bistro.

Note: Weather can be unpredictable and it is recommended to bring a jacket or windbreaker.

## TASSIE INDULGENCE – CHEESE, CHOCOLATE & WINE

**Burnie (Tasmania), Australia Tour Code: BWT\_05**

Enjoy a scenic drive through some of Tasmania's beautiful towns and indulge your senses with the flavors of locally made cheeses, chocolates and wine. Your indulgent experience begins in Burnie where you'll visit the Maker's Workshop. Here you'll learn all about the local cheese making industry and taste a variety of cheeses from the local manufacturers.

Head southeast for an hour through some of the beautiful towns dotted throughout Tasmania's north. Stop at a local chocolate factory that specializes in hand-crafted Belgian-style chocolates made with the freshest Tasmanian cream and butter. Learn about the art of chocolate making and indulge in some samples. Enjoy a delicious morning tea and browse the museum or gift shop.

Visit a local boutique winery where you'll be briefed on all aspects of the vineyard and enjoy a sampling of wine.

The wines are made in small quantities from grapes grown on local vines. Some of the vines in this area were among the first to be planted in this coastal region of Tasmania.

## Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
