## Tour Descriptions for Darwin, Australia

### DARWIN HARBOR CRUISE

Darwin, Australia Tour Code: DRW\_03

Enjoy a relaxing harbor cruise and panoramic tour of Darwin. In addition to being a modern tropical capital, Darwin is situated on a harbor twice the size of Sydney's. Board your chartered vessel and then sit back and relax while commentary is offered.

You'll learn of Darwin's unique history including the historical bombing in 1942 which sank 12 ships in the harbor. The harbor has huge tidal movements of up to 26 feet and the only 4 gate, salt-water loch in Australia. Once you have traveled through the loch and emerged into the harbor, you'll see Larrakeyah, the Naval Patrol boat base and Doctors Gully, home to a popular and unusual local attraction, made so by the hundreds of fish that come to shore at high tide to be fed by hand.

As you pass Darwin's Esplanade, you'll be able to see your ship berthed at the wharf. You'll be treated to a refreshment on board as you pass several interesting sights along the way. Re-board your coach and enjoy a panoramic tour of Darwin's highlights.

Note: The vessel used on the tour has both air-conditioned and non-air conditioned areas. Shoes with non-slip soles are recommended as well as a sun hat, sunglasses and sunscreen. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

### DARWIN MUSEUMS & CROCODYLUS PARK

Darwin, Australia Tour Code: DRW\_07

You'll travel a short distance to Crocodylus Park, well known for its crocodile research. Operated by wildlife research consultants, they will provide you with a very interesting presentation. You'll get to observe the crocodiles in the park's lagoon, as well as in their pens and witness a crocodile feeding. Amazingly, the crocodiles will literally leap several feet in the air for their food. You'll also have an opportunity to have a photo taken with a juvenile crocodile ... and you can even hold one.

Return to the city for a visit to the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory that overlooks Fannie Bay. The gallery houses a comprehensive display of Indigenous art and artifacts that reveal much about the various Aboriginal groups. You'll also find an excellent display of Aboriginal, South-East Asian and Oceanic art, along with a permanent collection of major Australian fine art.

You'll also visit the Australian Aviation Heritage Centre, which features an impressive presentation of aircraft and displays, of both civil and military aviation. The exhibits span from the early pioneers and record breakers through

World War II and the jet age of Vulcan's, Concorde and other aircraft. There is an awesome display of a B52 Bomber and other types of aircraft including a B-25 Mitchell, Mirage, and Sabre jet fighters. Your tour concludes with a brief overview of Darwin's highlights.

Note: Comfortable walking shoes, a sun hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and insect repellent are recommended. The Aviation Heritage Centre is not air-conditioned. Exhibits are constantly being upgraded, removed and changed. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

## HIGHLIGHTS OF DARWIN'S HISTORICAL PAST

Darwin, Australia Tour Code: DRW\_05

Darwin has a rich and colorful history and this tour highlights some important sights that help chronicle its past. Your fascinating journey starts with a visit to the Fannie Bay Gaol Museum - Darwin's original penal institution. You'll learn how from 1883 through 1979, the old gaol, with its crude facilities and a chilling old gallows section, has served as a grim reminder of what life there was really like.

Australian history was shaped by another phase, when colonial settlers traveled across the globe in the hope of finding a better world, eager to explore new lands in search of personal and financial growth. You'll stop at the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory, to complete your exploration of Darwin's heritage.

The gallery houses a comprehensive display of Indigenous art and artifacts that reveal much about the various Aboriginal groups. You'll also find an excellent display of Aboriginal, South-East Asian and Oceanic art, along with a permanent collection of major Australian fine art.

Note: This tour involves a moderate amount of walking. Wheelchair guests are required to have a collapsible wheelchair, must be able to make their own way on and off the coach and have an able-bodied companion to assist them. Exhibits are constantly being upgraded, removed and changed. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

## JUMPING CROCODILE CRUISE

Darwin, Australia Tour Code: DRW\_04

You'll travel to the Adelaide River, one of eight rivers in the Top End which have large flood plains. These flood plains create a great expanse of coastal wetlands that are home to a variety of unique animals and plant life. The Northern Territory is also well known as crocodile country. You'll stop at the Window on the Wetlands Visitors

Centre where you'll have the opportunity to learn more about life in this tropical region.

At the Adelaide River, you'll board a boat for your cruise which brings you almost face-to-face with the crocodiles. Keep watch for the tell-tale ripples of an approaching reptile, camera ready in anticipation of capturing that crocodile as it leaps out of the water. For your refreshment, a soft drink will be offered while you are aboard the vessel.

Note: The cruise is not exclusive to Norwegian Cruise Line guests. It is recommended that guests wear comfortable walking shoes with non-slip soles and bring a sun hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and insect repellent. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

## TERRITORY WILDLIFE PARK

Darwin, Australia Tour Code: DRW\_01

Visit the Territory Wildlife Park, nestled in some 400 hectares of natural bushland and offers over 4 miles of walking trails that pass through abundant woodlands, lush wetlands and tropical forest. For the convenience of visitors, carriages pulled by small trucks are available which navigate around the park, providing commentary along the way.

The park offers a vast array of native wildlife, such as kangaroos, wallabies, buffalo, tropical birds, dingoes, crocodiles and Banteng cattle. There is an underwater walk-through aquarium where can gliding whip rays, other colorful fish and marine life. The Nocturnal House offers a glimpse into the lives of many species of nocturnal animals that are rarely seen in the wild. There is also a special enclosure where a scheduled performance will be held where you can observe birds of prey in full flight.

Although guides will greet your coach, provide maps and offer suggestions and assistance, what you see and experience here is at your discretion. It is suggested that you first cover those exhibits you most want to see in the time allotted.

Note: Guests must meet at the designated pick-up point at the time advised by the driver. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

## Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
