Tour Descriptions for Kaohsiung, Taiwan

A GLIMPSE OF KAOHSIUNG

Kaohsiung, Taiwan Tour Code: KAO_03

This definitive tour of Kaohsiung presents attractions that reveal the very fabric of life in this thriving southern Taiwanese city. You'll travel to the massive Spring and Autumn Pavilions, a complex completed in 1951 and embrace the breathtaking sight that shows the importance of legend in Taiwanese culture.

As religious expression is very prevalent in Kaohsiung you'll also visit two of its most popular Taiwanese temples, the Confucius Temple and Chiming Tang. Completed in 1976, the Confucius Temple is Taiwan's largest Confucian temple and expresses a deep reverence for China's beloved sage. Chiming Tang was constructed in the 1970s. Several different gods are worshipped here, including humanized gods of influential historic figures, such as Confucius.

Head to the Chijin Old Street for a glimpse of daily life in Kaohsiung and where the city was first developed. Colorful, ornate temples such as the 300-year-old Tian Ho abound, and the many small shops are always abuzz. As you stroll along the street exploring the many sights, shops and stands, you will no doubt feel the friendly townspeople and the inviting ambience that is found here.

Note: This tour involves approximately 90-minutes of moderate walking with numerous steps to negotiate at the temples. The tour is available to wheelchair guests who have a collapsible wheelchair, are able to make their own way on and off the coach and have a companion to assist them, although they may not be able to enjoy all the sights at the temples.

HIGHLIGHTS OF KAOHSIUNG

Kaohsiung, Taiwan Tour Code: KAO_02

Gain a greater understanding of Taiwanese culture by touring the must-see destinations in and around Kaohsiung, the country's second largest metropolis. A drive through the countryside takes you towards Fokuanghan, a famed center of Buddhism founded in 1967 by Buddhist master Shingyun and painstakingly built into the mountainside. Fokuanghan or Light of Buddha Mountain features an array of temples, meditation halls, gardens and exhibition halls displaying spectacular religious artifacts. You'll be treated to a vegetarian luncheon at Fokuangshan consisting of traditional dishes made with fresh, locally grown ingredients.

Understand the temples intent of making Buddhism relevant in modern life as you tour Fokuangshan's impressive Buddhist Cultural Museum, filled with ritual instruments, beautiful calligraphy, and significant objects d' art carved out of jade, bronze and porcelain. The works are from various countries and time periods, providing an in-depth

view of Buddhism.

You'll drive back to Kaohsiung to the Confucius Temple, situated on serene Lotus Pond, so named for the many fragrant lotus flowers growing in the water. Completed in 1976, this majestic structure is Taiwan's largest Confucian temple and expresses a deep reverence for China's beloved sage. You'll also visit Chiming Tang, another Taiwanese temple constructed in the 1970s. Several different gods are worshipped here, including humanized gods of influential historic figures, such as Confucius.

Note: This tour involves approximately 3 1/2 hours of moderate to strenuous walking with numerous steps to negotiate.

SACRED FOKUANGSHAN

Kaohsiung, Taiwan Tour Code: KAO 01

Immerse yourself in Buddhism at Taiwan's largest Buddhist monastery, Fokuangshan, a serene mountain complex overlooking the Kaoping River. Approaching the monastery founded in 1967 by Buddhist master Shingyun, you'll notice several giant statues of Buddha in the distance. Painstakingly built into the mountainside, Fokuanghan or Light of Buddha Mountain features an array of characteristic temples, meditation halls, gardens and exhibition halls displaying spectacular religious artifacts. Nearly 15,000 lanterns rest in the openings of the walls of the four shrines, with Tahsiungpao being the largest of the shrines.

Understand the intent of making Buddhism relevant in modern life as you tour Fokuangshan's impressive Buddhist Cultural Museum, filled with ritual instruments, beautiful calligraphy, and significant objects d' art carved out of jade, bronze and porcelain. The works are from various countries and time periods, providing an in-depth view of Buddhism.

You'll be treated to a vegetarian luncheon at Fokuangshan consisting of traditional dishes made with fresh, locally grown ingredients.
