Tour Descriptions for Melbourne, Australia

BEST OF MELBOURNE – PUFFING BILLY, NATURE & WINE

Melbourne, Australia Tour Code: MEL_09

Explore the striking beauty of deep, fern-covered valleys and eucalyptus forests during this journey by coach and rail through the Dandenong Ranges. You'll drive through the suburb of Ferntree Gully, and on to the quaint township of Belgrave where you will board Puffing Billy, a vintage, narrow-gauge steam train. Take in wonderful views and photo opportunities of the picturesque scenery as your train weaves its way through the beautiful countryside.

Upon reaching Menzies Creek, you'll reboard your coach and make a visit to one of the numerous wineries in this region. After lunch at a winery, you'll be invited to participate in a wine tasting. Next, you will cross the Great Dividing Range for a stop at the Healesville Sanctuary. Regarded as one of Australia's leading parks, it features over 200 species of native wildlife in a natural bush setting. Here, you can get acquainted with the kangaroos, koalas, lyrebirds, platypus, emus, and other Australian animals. You'll have approximately 1 1/2 hours of free time to explore the park. Your tour concludes with a brief orientation tour of Melbourne's most popular sites.

Note: The steam locomotive is not air-conditioned, and may be replaced by a diesel train on fire-danger days. Total amount of walking and exertion is at guests' discretion.

KANGAROOS & KOALAS

Melbourne, Australia Tour Code: MEL_03

Discover the unique wildlife of Australia. You'll visit the Serandip Open Range Sanctuary, located on the vast Western Plains. Upon arrival, you'll join an expert nature guide for an informative introduction to Australia's wildlife. You will see large groups of free-range, Eastern gray kangaroos in a natural bush setting, and learn interesting facts about other Australian animals and birds. See a protected population of wallabies and get close to some native birds in their natural habitat before enjoying a BBQ lunch. Meet some of the local Aboriginal tribe, the Wathaurong who will share elements of their culture with you and perform some music on their didgeridoo.

Next, you will proceed to a nearby national park to view koalas in the wild. Accompanied by a nature guide, you will see and learn about these extraordinary creatures in their natural environment. Towards the end of the walk you'll visit the Big Rock Aboriginal Cultural Site, considered to be one of the most significant sites in the region.

Note: This tour involves approximately 1 1/2 hours of walking over uneven and natural ground. Guests are strongly advised to wear comfortable clothing and walking shoes, and bring binoculars.

MELBOURNE PAST & PRESENT

Melbourne, Australia Tour Code: MEL_10

Explore the highlights of Melbourne past and present during this scenic orientation tour of the city. Melbourne is renowned for its beautiful parks and gardens that surround the city. You'll visit the Eureka Skydeck the highest observation deck in the Southern Hemisphere. The elevators will take you take you from the ground up to the 88 floor, in just 40 seconds for unparalleled 360 degree views of the city, Port Phillip Bay and the Dandenong Ranges.

You'll stop at the Shrine of Remembrance one of the most recognizable landmarks of Melbourne. Here you'll have time to take photos and climb up to the balcony if you are feeling energetic. From here, you will travel past the modern Crown Casino complex and Convention Center, then proceed through the residential suburbs of South Yarra and Toorak, home of Melbourne's elite. The highlight of your tour will be a visit to the Melbourne Museum, where you will be explore on your own before meeting back at the coach at the designated time.

LEISURELY MELBOURNE

Melbourne, Australia Tour Code: MEL_06

This mostly panoramic tour will allow you to explore the highlights of Melbourne from the comfort of your coach. You'll travel through the streets of Melbourne to the picturesque bayside suburb of St. Kilda, with its lovely beaches and vibrant café lifestyle. Along the way, your guide will share with you stories about the sites and events in the city's colorful history.

Continue onto Albert Park where you'll pass by the Australian Grand Prix track before making a stop at the Shrine of Remembrance, one of the most recognizable landmarks of Melbourne. Here you'll have time to take photos and climb up to the balcony if you are feeling energetic. Your tour will pass by the MCG sporting precinct that became famous during the 1956 Olympic Games and now used for Aussie Rules Football, cricket and music concerts. You'll also see the Rod Laver Tennis Center, home to the Australian Tennis Open.

Entering the city center, you'll pass by many landmark buildings, including The Treasury, Parliament House, the Windsor Hotel, the Princess Theatre and the amazing Gothic buildings along Collins Street. Travel through the Carlton district where you can see the historic Exhibition Buildings which stand alongside the ultramodern Melbourne Museum.

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
