BOMBAY BY LIGHTS & DINNER EXPERIENCE

Mumbai, India Tour Code: BOM 07

This city of many facets that enjoys its status as a commercial capital by day transforms itself from a flourishing center of commerce and trade into a dazzling entertainment center when the sun sets and the lights come on.

As dusk falls, you'll leave the pier and find yourself in the sparkling after-dark ambience of this intriguing city. You'll make a visit to the Regal Cinema Hall, Bombay's first art deco theater, where you'll have a short viewing of a typical Hindi film. Nicknamed Bollywood, the city's film industry actually produces more movies per year than Hollywood.

Drive past the impressive gothic style buildings of the High Court, the Art District of Kala Ghoda, Victoria Terminus, the Center of Science and the landmark Gateway of India at Apollo Blunder - Illuminated at night each of these notable sights seems to take on a distinctive and perhaps more captivating character than is seen during the day.

Bombay's nightlife is characterized by its countless restaurants, street-side cafés, bars and private clubs. It is in one of these venues that you'll have the opportunity to meet some local 'Bombayites' while relaxing and enjoying drinks and dinner. The cuisine combined with the easy-going and friendly natures of your local hosts makes for a truly memorable experience. Rejoin your coach and travel down Marine Drive with the curved shape of the bay being accented by thousands of sparkling lights and make a stop at a local night market. You'll have time to stroll amongst the stalls and shop for silks and jewelry while enjoying the aroma of exotic spices.

HIGHLIGHTS OF BOMBAY

Mumbai, India Tour Code: BOM 01

The fastest growing, most affluent and industrialized city in India, Mumbai represents the ever-changing face of today's India - the old coupled with the dynamic new. Experience the elements and sights that have shared a long association and characterized the city with a spiritual experience at ISKCON; the temple of the International Society for Krishna Consciousness. You'll be able to witness the prayer chanting offered for the welfare of humanity.

Drive up to posh Malabar hill making a stop at the Hanging Gardens to experience the city's most exclusive neighborhood. Sought after since the 18th century for its forested slopes, fresh sea breeze and panoramic views,

you'll find mansions and bungalows built by wealthy merchants and colonial generals alongside modern high-rises.

Stop for photos at the colorful Dhobi Ghat for a once in a lifetime sight where thousands of pieces of clothing are sent each day to be laundered, dried and ironed by Mumbais' laundry men and women, the dhobi wallahs. You'll visit Mani Bavan, the Gandhi Memorial, containing a reference library with over 2,000 books, memorabilia and a photo feature on the Mahatma's life. Additional photo stops will be made as you pass by the city's highlights.

Spend time at the Prince of Wales Museum, opened in 1923, built to commemorate King George V's royal visit to India, and see an impressive collection of artifacts from Elephanta Island and the Jogeshwari Caves, ivory carvings, terracotta figurines from the Indus valley, and a large collection of miniature paintings. You'll visit another structure built to commemorate the visit of King George V and Queen Mary in 1911 and is a principal landmark in Mumbai, the Gateway of India.

Note: This tour involves approximately 2 hours of moderate walking/standing with several steps to negotiate at some of the venues visited. Shoes and shorts are not allowed in temples.

RELIGIOUS BEATS

Mumbai, India Tour Code: BOM 03

You'll develop a deeper understanding into the varied religions that are represented in Bombay through a special selection of visits to places of worship which symbolize the unique social scene found here.

Stop in the popular middle class settlement of Dadar at the recognized Guruvayur and Ram temple complex, constructed in South Indian style, it has a majestic upper complex containing five sacred gold plated urns. Opposite Dadar railway station is the impressive three spired Swaminarayan temple erected out of pink sandstone in traditional architectural style with intricate carving.

You'll make your way downtown along the coastline, passing Haji Ali mosque and tomb, where you next see the oldest sacred fire in Bombay that was installed in 1709 and housed in the Bomanji Wadia Fire Temple. You'll be able to view from the outside as only worshippers are permitted in.

Stop for lunch at a local hotel before turning to the Jewish influence that has helped shape the historical and commercial success of Bombay. The arrival of the Baghdadi Jews brought synagogue life to its prominence. Jacob Sassoon built the Keneseth Eliyahoo Synagogue in the "Fort" area. The synagogue, with its white wooden staircase, decorative floor tiles and fine stained-glass is patronized by both Baghdadi and Bene Israel communities.

While Roman Catholicism continued to thrive in the Bombay region even after the departure of the Portuguese, the Anglican Church made its presence felt with the coming of the British in 1661. Commissioned in 1715, St. Thomas' Cathedral, the first in the city, contains fine stained-glass windows and choice objects of worship that

was selected for the UNESCO Asia Pacific Conservation award.

Note: This tour involves a significant amount of walking over uneven terrain at time and has steps to negotiate. As tour visits religious sites, please dress appropriately - no bare shoulders, shorts, or skirts above the knee. Slipon shoes are recommended as shoes must be removed before entering temples.
