## Tour Descriptions for Sihanoukville, Cambodia

### HIGHLIGHTS OF SIHANOUKVILLE

Sihanoukville, Cambodia Tour Code: SH1\_03

Enjoy this overview of the distinctive charms of Sihanoukville, a beach-rimmed resort city known for its relaxed attitude and traditional pagodas. Drive to Wat Krom, a pagoda where many residents of Sihanoukville practice Buddhism. Here, you may see monks chanting, and young monks learning Pali, the sacred language of the Buddhist scriptures. Most of the pagodas in town are brightly painted and decorated with deities represented by hooded snakes, particularly king cobras. They are called nagas, a Sanskrit word for serpent.

Stop for photos at the famed Golden Lion Monument located on a roundabout, named for its statues of these jungle beasts. Make your way to a bustling local market, known for extraordinary seafood, which you'll see displayed here along with fresh vegetables. Your final stop is Ochheuteal Beach, one of the city's most popular beaches where you'll have approximately a half hour to relax or walk on the beach.

Note: This tour involves approximately 2 hours of moderate to easy walking, at times over some natural and uneven surfaces, plus any walking at guests' discretion during free time at the beach.

### REAM NATIONAL PARK BY BOAT

Sihanoukville, Cambodia Tour Code: SH1\_04

Nature lovers rejoice and visit Ream National Park, a wonderland of evergreen forests and mangrove swamps teeming with indigenous wildlife. It's truly a paradise that clearly shows Cambodia's commitment to preserving its endangered wildlife and ecosystems.

It's a drive through lush countryside to reach the edge of Ream National Park. Established in 1993, the park sprawls over approximately 60,000 acres, providing a pristine, protected environment for birds, monkeys, and all sorts of marine life. A boat ride on a typical wooden boat allows you to enjoy the natural view along the mangrove-lined river, Prek Toeuk Sap. Watch for wildlife as you make your way through the mangrove channels and into the Gulf of Thailand with scenic views of the green islands.

Transfer to the beach where you'll have approximately one hour to walk around, relax or get in the water before continuing for a short visit to the mountain pagoda, with its typical Khemer architecture. You might have a chance to observe the monks during their rituals.

Note: The park is maintained by the government and guests should be prepared to experience some areas in need of repair or maintenance. Light-weight casual clothing; sunglasses; sun cap; sunscreen; insect repellent and flat,

comfortable walking shoes are suggested. Wildlife sightings, while common in the park, are not guaranteed. Those who wish to swim at the beach should bring swimwear, proper sun protection and a towel from the ship.

## SIHANOUKVILLE IN DEPTH

Sihanoukville, Cambodia Tour Code: SH1\_02

Discover Sihanoukville through the eyes of its locals. Visit a temple where you'll see monks' residences, take a glimpse at the daily life of the villagers and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Begin your journey with a drive through the countryside to Puthuong, a traditional village nestled amongst a landscape dotted with rice fields and stop to visit a local temple adorned with traditional Apsara fairy dancer statues. Here you'll also see the monks' residences and dining hall as well as the homes of the nuns around the temple.

A short walk brings you to the heart of the village where you'll have the opportunity to take a glimpse into the residents' daily lives. As you watch the villagers go about their day, your guide will explain how they raise domestic animals, prepare traditional dishes, and worship their ancestors. Stop at the Psa Leu market where colorful displays of fish, poultry, palm sugar and fruits are yours to briefly explore.

After lunch at a local restaurant, make your way to the south side of Sihanoukville where you'll have a little over one hour at Ochheuteal Beach, one of the most popular beaches, to relax.

## Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
