HIGHLIGHTS OF WELLINGTON

Wellington, New Zealand Tour Code: WLG_01

Discover the historical and scenic highlights of New Zealand's center of government and culture, known as the "Capital of Cool". A picturesque drive along lovely Oriental Bay toward Mount Victoria offers a spectacular 360 view of Wellington and its well-protected harbor. Visit the Wellington Botanical Garden, established in the 1860s. Strolling through this wonderland of exotic and indigenous plants, you'll see rare specimens of begonias, heritage roses, and aromatic herbs. The lily pond is also worth noting because of its enormous water lilies and the carnivorous plants nearby.

History takes center stage as you drive down Bowen Street, home to New Zealand's Parliament, which has been meeting here since 1865. The most iconic building within this sprawling government complex is the Executive Wing, known as "The Beehive" for its distinctive shape. It provides quite an architectural contrast to the Parliament House, an Edwardian neo-classical building. You'll pass the contemporary Wellington Cathedral before arriving at Old Paul's, the city's former cathedral. Constructed entirely of native timbers, the interior is absolutely stunning, especially the wooden rafters and stained-glass windows. Although no longer a parish church, the cathedral remains a place of great spiritual significance.

Note: Wheelchair guests are required to have a collapsible wheelchair must be able to make their own way on and off the coach and have an able-bodied companion to assist them. Tour may operate with a driver/guide.

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF LORD OF THE RINGS

Take a behind-the-scenes look at the making of The Lord of the Rings film trilogy when visiting director Peter Jackson's special-effects studio, Weta Cave. Join a trilogy expert guide and visit the suburb of Miramar, now also known as "Wellywood", the heart of the New Zealand film industry.

Take a stroll through the picturesque forest of the 'Outer Shire' where Frodo and the Hobbits began their journey. Learn how the films were made while visiting scenes and locations right in the heart of Wellington City. You'll have the exclusive opportunity to visit "Weta Studios - The Weta Workshop". Get a unique behind-the-scenes glimpse into the workings of Weta Workshop and learn about the processes and creative thinking that goes on within the walls of this custom built facility. They may even reveal some of the secrets behind the movie magic!

Exclusive video clips are displayed throughout the tour, as well as descriptive boards describing the processes used. The exhibition space reveals the history of Weta Workshop and what they have been busy with over the

past 20 years. Enjoy a private screening of a 25-minute behind-the-scenes film depicting the history of the film industry in Wellington which features interviews with Weta Workshop co-founders Peter Jackson, Richard Taylor, Tania Rodger and Jamie Selkirk. Your return drive takes you via Evans Bay & Oriental Bay for stunning views of Wellington city and harbor.

PENCARROW STATION & THE STORM COAST

Wellington, New Zealand Tour Code: WLG_02

Follow the harbor past Petone where Wellington's first settlers landed, and then travel along a coastline dotted with shipwrecks, quaint villages and quiet bays. As you sit back and enjoy the passing scenery, a narrative will be provided that relates the many stories that are now etched into the folklore of this dramatic piece of New Zealand coast.

Arriving at Pencarrow Station, a nearly 2,000-acre sheep and cattle farm which is also home to New Zealand's oldest lighthouse, you'll have the opportunity to visit one of Wellington's best kept secrets, Pencarrow Lodge. This remote, isolated cottage originally housed a farm worker and was built during a period of local cattle rustling as a security measure to protect against cattle thieves. The view from this location, which stretches across the Cook Strait to the snow-capped Kaikoura Ranges in the South Island, is simply spectacular. Here, enjoy a refreshment of tea and cakes.

SEAL COAST SAFARI

Wellington, New Zealand Tour Code: WLG_03

Head into the unspoiled wilds in a 4-wheel drive vehicle, where you'll see a thriving colony of fur seals in their natural habitat. Take off in a 4-wheel-drive vehicle specifically designed for traversing rugged terrain. The landscape surrounding Wellington is wonderfully wild, so you can expect an incredible scenic ride. At Tongue Point, you'll drive onto the beach to observe a thriving colony of fur seals.

Once pushed to the brink of extinction, fur seals have made a steady comeback since being protected by law in

1978. While their thick layers of fat and fur allow them to endure long periods of time in the water, fur seals can overheat on land so they often head back into the sea. A typical dive may last between one to two minutes, although fur seals can remain underwater for as long as eleven minutes. Being carnivorous, they feed on fish, squid and octopus. You'll spend approximately two hours watching the quite social animals at play.

Note: Tour involves walking over a sandy beach and rocky surfaces. Drive is off-road on bumpy terrain; not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back, hip and/or neck problems or limited mobility. There are no toilet facilities either en route or at the beach. Casual clothing; flat, sturdy walking shoes and a light jacket or raincoat is recommended. Tour operates with a driver/guide.

Activity Levels

- ACTIVITY LEVEL 1** Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 2** Involves a considerable amount of physical activity such as substantial walking over cobblestone streets, climbing stairs or steep terrain. They're not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. Comfortable, sturdy shoes are recommended.
- ACTIVITY LEVEL 3** Involves physical exertion for extended periods. The terrain may be uneven or steep. It can also indicate a need for swimming in a light current, biking or horseback riding. Recommended only for physically fit and adventurous travelers.
